

Prof. Dr. P. Ishwara Bhat

Vice Chancellor



Padil Ishwara Bhat is a legal academician from Karnataka. Being a gold medallist in constitutional law in LL. B. (1977) and first rank holder and gold medallist in LL.M. (1979) from the University of Mysore, he chose academic career of law teaching in 1979 and has 40 years of experience in this field. He taught at Karnatak University Dharwad, and subsequently at Department of Studies Law, University of Mysore. He obtained Ph D degree in law in on a thesis entitled, 'Interrelationship among Fundamental Rights'. He has also M A degree in history. He got LL D degree from National Law School of India University for a thesis on non-profit law.

He excelled in research and academic legal writing and got exposure to international experience. He received Shastri Indo Canadian Research Award in 1992, and researched on comparative study of language rights in Canada and India in Canadian Universities. He handled research projects on multiculturalism in Indian Constitutional law and International Humanitarian Law and on Space Law. He was a visiting professor in Queens University, Kingston, Canada in 2009. As Fulbright Fellow he involved in co-teaching in Columbus Law School, Catholic University of America, Washington for four months in 2010. He had exposure to American Civilization course as Salzburg fellow in 1997. He has guided 20 Ph D scholars.

His books include: 'Fundamental Rights' (ELH, 2004); 'Law and Social Transformation' (EBC, 2009) 'Non-profit Voluntary Organisations Law' (EBC, 2018); and 'Idea and Methods of Legal Research' (Oxford University Press, 2019). These are comprehensive treatises well-received by the academic community. He has also published 125 research articles in reputed national and international journals and books. He has edited books on 'Constitutionalism and constitutional pluralism' (2013), 'International and national water disputes law' (2013), 'Natural Resources Law' (2016) 'Essays in law' (2002) and 'DD Basu's 'Limited Government and Judicial review' (2015) and two books in Kannada.

He served as Dean for three terms and acting Vice Chancellor for four months in the University of Mysore, Vice Chancellor of the West Bengal National University of juridical Sciences, Kolkata. He was appointed as Vice Chancellor of the Karnataka State Law University in 2018. As Vice chancellor he has contributed immensely to the research activities and improvement of the quality of legal education in the respective universities.

Today in recognition of his outstanding contribution to Legal Research Prof P. Ishwara Bhat is being conferred Capital Foundation Prof Upendra Baxi National Award.
