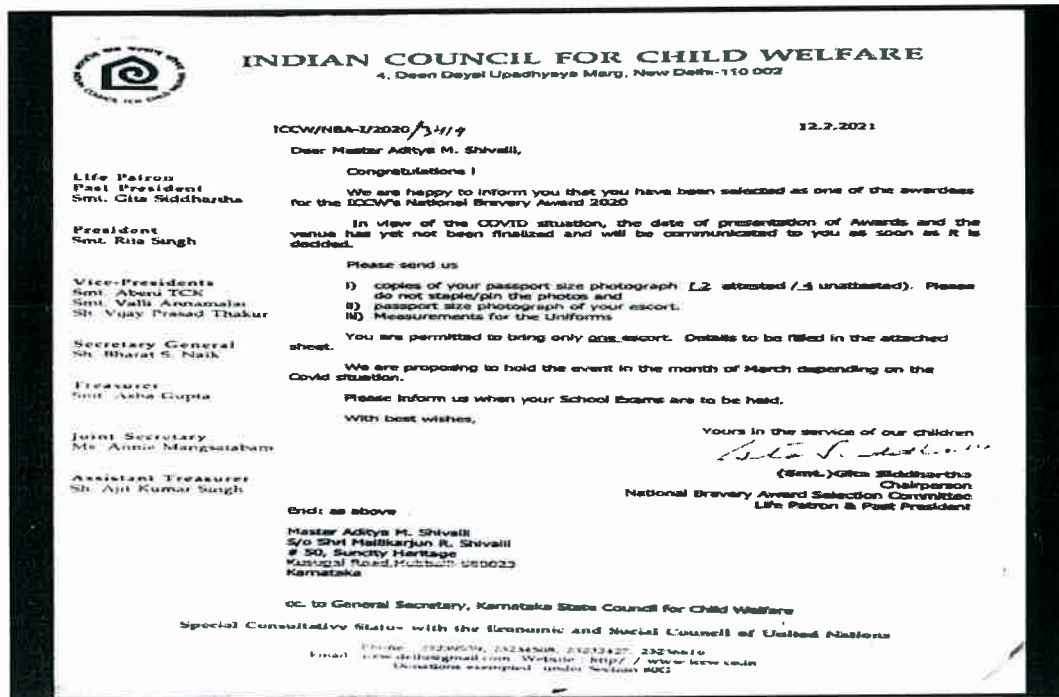

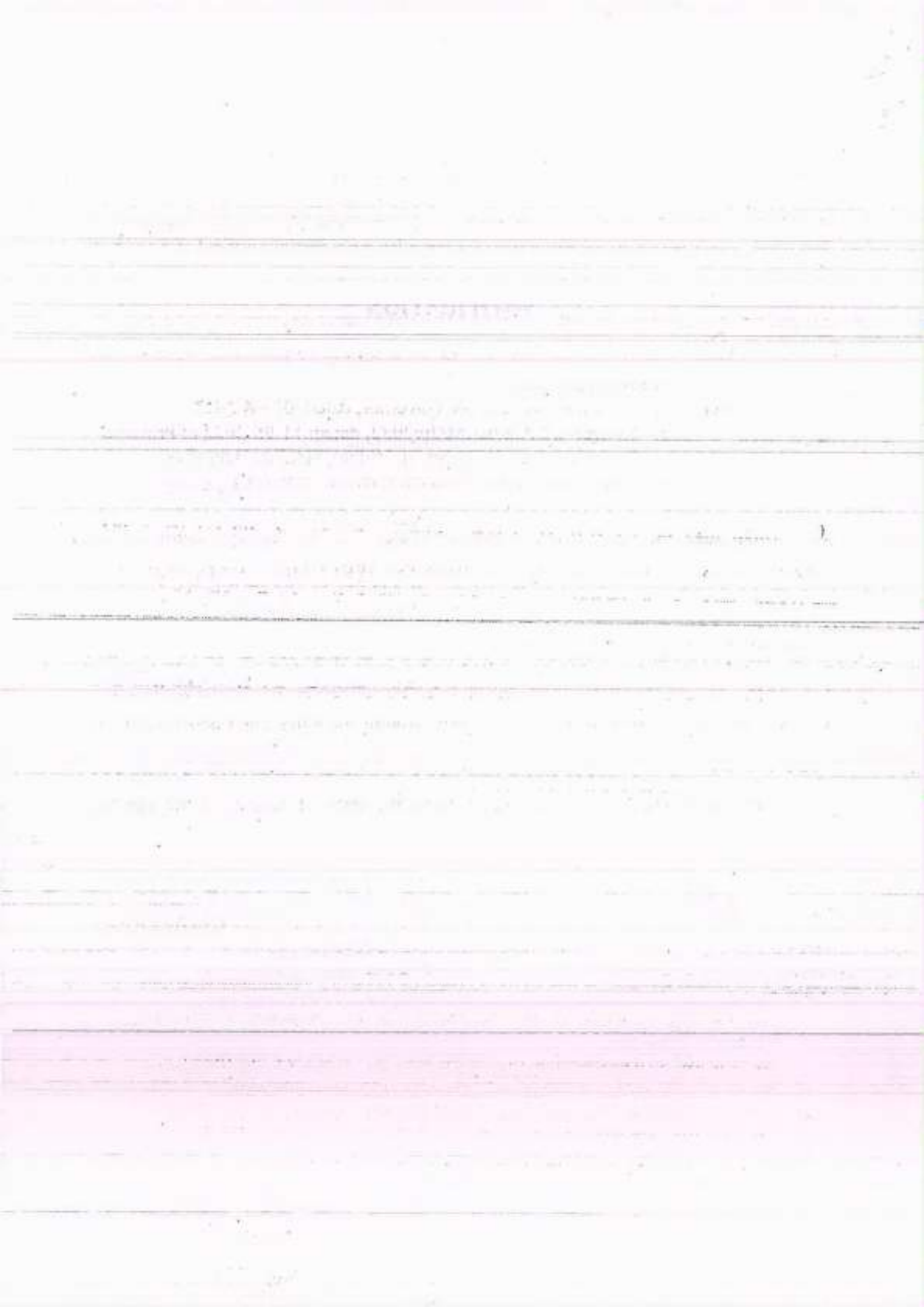

STATUTE RELATING TO THE STUDENTS' WELFARE FUND, 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 47 read with Sections 43 and 53 of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009 (Karnataka Act No.11 of 2009), the Syndicate of Karnataka State Law University hereby makes the following Statute, namely:

1. TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICATION -

- (a) This Statute shall be called as "Statute relating to the Students' Welfare Fund".
- (b) This Statute shall come into force from the date of assent of the Chancellor.
- (c) This Statute shall apply to the students who are undergoing full time under graduation programme or post graduation programme in Law School or Autonomous Law College or Affiliated Law Colleges (Government or Aided or unaided private college or institution) of the University.

2. DEFINITIONS -

- (a) "Act" means the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.
- (b) "Autonomous Law College" means a Law college or institution (Government or Aided or unaided private college or institution) situated within the jurisdiction of the University and affiliated to and recognised as Autonomous Law College by the University as per the Statute of the University.
- (c) "Affiliated Law College" means a Law college or institution (Government or Aided or unaided private college or institution) situated within the jurisdiction of the University and affiliated to the University as per the Statute of the University.
- (d) "Law School" means a Law School established and maintained by the University within its campus as per the Statute relating the Establishment of Karnataka State Law University's Law School.

- (e) "Principal" means the Director of Law School or Head of autonomous law college or affiliated law colleges (Government or Aided or unaided private college or institution) of the University.
- (f) "Relatives" means the spouse, parents or children of a student.
- (g) "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Statute.
- (h) "Student" means a student undergoing full time under graduation programme or post graduation programme in Law School or Autonomous Law College or Affiliated Law Colleges (Government or Aided or unaided private college or institution) of the University.
- (i) "Students' Welfare Fund" means fund created as per the provision of this statute for the welfare of the students.
- (j) "Students Welfare Fund Committee" means a Committee duly constituted as per the provision of this Statute.
- (k) "Economically Weaker Section" means a person or his family holding BPL card.
- (l) Words and expressions used and not defined in this Statute but defined in the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009 shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in that Act.

3. CONSTITUTION OF STUDENTS WELFARE FUND -

- (1) The University, with the approval of the Syndicate, shall constitute a fund to be called as the "Students Welfare Fund".
- (2) There shall be credited to the Fund-
- (a) All amounts remitted to the head "Students Welfare Fund" of the University;
- (b) Remuneration surrendered by the paper setters, examiners, valuers, re-valuers and scrutinizers in favour of the Fund;

- (3) The University may modify or alter the composition of the Committee from time to time as per the decisions of the Syndicate.
- (4) The tenure of a member of the Committee, other than the members enumerated under sub-clauses (a) to (f), shall be two years from the date of assuming of the office.
- (5) Whenever the office of the member of the Committee falls vacant by reason of resignation, incapacity, death, retirement, etc. the University shall fill the vacancy as soon as possible.
- (6) There shall be not less than three meetings of the Committee in a year. Provided, depending on the urgency and necessity, the Vice-Chancellor may convene a special meetings of the Committee as and when required.
- (7) No business shall be transacted at the meeting of the Committee unless at least five members are present in the meeting including the Chairperson.
- (8) If the quorum is not complete, fifteen minutes after the notified time of the meeting then the Chairperson of the Committee shall adjourn the meeting to such hours on the same day or to such date and hours as he/she specifies.
- (9) No quorum shall be necessary for the adjourned meeting of the Committee.
- (10) No act or proceeding of the Committee shall be invalid merely by reason of, any vacancy in, or any defect in the constitution of, the Committee or any irregularity in the procedure of the Committee not affecting the merits of the case.

- (c) Any voluntary donation or contribution made to the Fund by any association, institution, agency or other persons;
- (d) All interests accrued to the Fund;
- (e) Any contribution or grant given by the State Government in favour of the Fund;
- (f) Interest on the investment made out of the Fund, if any.

4. **UTILISATION OF FUND FOR STUDENT WELFARE ACTIVITIES** - The fund shall be utilised for giving financial assistance to the students of the University as decided by the Students Welfare Fund Committee in accordance with this statute. Financial assistance will be granted for the following Student Welfare Schemes:

- (a) Giving awards for outstanding performance in the fields of research, moot court and other competitions, cultural activities, N.S.S., Legal Aid activities etc. The Committee may grant certificate and cash award to the students. The award shall be given to one male and one female student in each category.
- (b) Cash prize for contributing well researched original articles to the KSLU's Students Law Journal or any other publications of the University. The University may give three such prizes to the students.
- (c) Full/partial financial support to students participating in National or International Conferences/ Seminars/Workshops.
- (d) Full/partial financial support to students selected to represent the University for various national or international events.
- (e) Financial Aid for supporting Education to students belonging to economically weaker section.
- (f) For any such other cause as may be deemed appropriate by the Students' Welfare Fund Committee from time to time.

5. **ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND** -

- (1) For the purpose of the administration of the Fund, the University shall constitute a Committee to be called as the 'Students Aid Fund Committee'.
- (2) The Committee shall consist of the following:

- (b) It may seek further information or documents from the applicant to justify his/her claims and after receipt of same, may take appropriate decision as it may deem fit;
- (c) After scrutiny, if the committee finds that the claims are not genuine or not admissible under the Statute then it may reject the application. The reasons for the rejection of the application shall be communicated to the applicant by the University.
- (d) If the committee finds that the claims are genuine then it may accept the application.
- (e) After accepting the application the committee has to determine the extent of the grant to be given to the applicant. Once it is determined the committee has to prepare a report recommending the extent of grant to be given to the applicant.
- (f) The said report has to be placed before the Syndicate for its approval.
- (g) The Syndicate shall have the power either to accept the recommendations of the committee or modify such recommendations as it may deem fit.
- (h) The decision of the Syndicate in this regard shall be final.
- (i) The University shall issue the order for disbursement of the grant to the applicant in accordance with the approval given by the Syndicate.
- (j) The Committee shall also have the power of taking *suo motto* cognizance of assistance required by any student and same may be placed in its meeting for consideration.
- (k) In relation to the matters taken up *suo motto* by the Committee, it shall have the same powers as mentioned in this Statute.

10. OPERATION OF THE FUND –

- (1) The University shall open a separate Savings Bank Account in any Scheduled Bank paying higher rate of interest in the name of "Karnataka State Law University's Students Welfare Fund".
- (2) This Account shall be operated jointly by and under the signature of the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the University.
- (3) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall maintain separate account book for this Account and submit the annual statements of account before the Committee as and when its meeting is convened.

- (11) The members mentioned under Sub-Clauses (d), (g) and (h) of Clause 2 of this Rule shall be paid the sitting fees, T.A. and D.A. as admissible to the Syndicate Members of the University in accordance with the Rules of the University.
6. **MAINTENANCE AND UPDATING OF LIST OF THE STUDENTS** - The Academic Section of the University shall maintain and update the list of the students and same shall be furnished to Finance Section of the University periodically.
7. **PROCEDURE FOR AVAILING THE ASSISTANCE** -
- (1) A student who is desirous of availing the assistance under this Statute shall submit an application in the prescribed format along with the necessary documents to the Registrar of the University.
- (2) After the receipt of the application, the Registrar shall forward the same to the Member Secretary of the Committee.
- (3) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall furnish the information of all such applications received under this Statute to the Finance Officer and the Vice-Chancellor.
- (4) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall place all such applications received under this Statute before the Committee for its consideration.
8. **THE PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE COMMITTEE** -
- (1) The Committee shall evolve the procedure which it deems fit for the purpose of examining the application submitted by a student for assistance.
- (2) On receipt of the applications, the Committee shall take appropriate decision with respect to such applications at least within 120 working days from the date of receipt of the application.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may grant extension of 30 days time for the said purpose if there are justifiable reasons.
9. **POWERS OF THE COMMITTEE** -
- (1) On receipt of the application for assistance, the Committee shall examine the genuineness of claims as per its procedure. Thereafter, it may exercise the powers in following ways:
- (a) It has to scrutinize the application for examining the genuineness of claims;


(5) The University may deposit the un-utilised amount of this Fund in the fixed deposit in any Scheduled Bank.

11. **GRANTS TO THE STUDENTS** - The Committee, on an application submitted by a student or *suo motto*, after being satisfied about the genuineness of the claim, may recommend for grant to be made from the Fund in favour of the applicant for any of the purposes stipulated under this Statute.

Explanation-1: The extent of the grant that can be given is mentioned in the Schedule of this Statute. The Syndicate through its resolution shall have the power to enhance the grants mentioned in the Schedule up-to 10% from case to case basis.

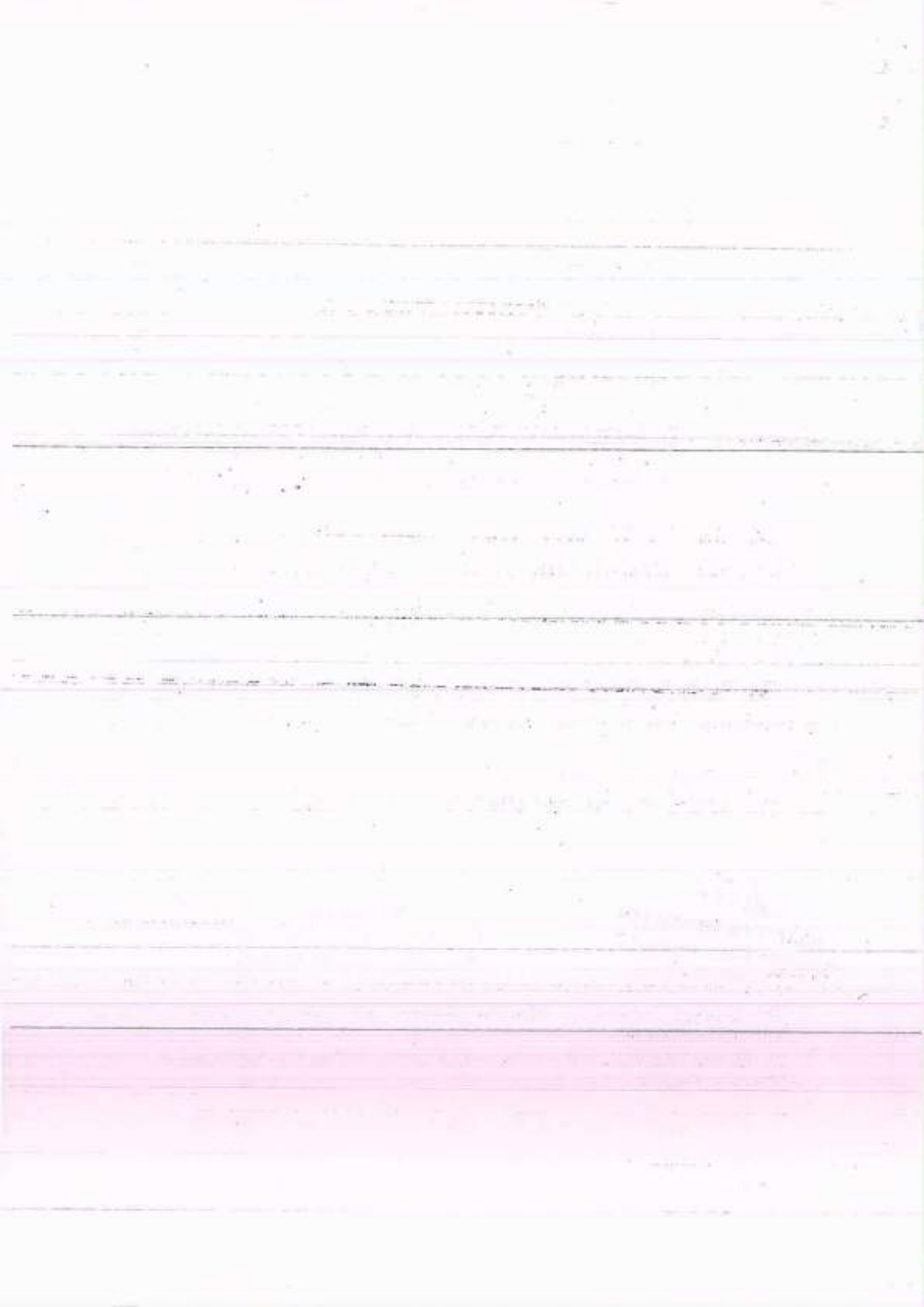

4. OBJECTIVES OF THE FUND - The Funds which are generated under the Students Aid Fund shall be utilized for the following objectives:

- (a) To provide assistance, financial or otherwise, in case of sickness (Mental or physical) requiring hospitalisation beyond two days, permanent or partial disability, injuries sustained due to accident occurring within the premises of the Law School, Autonomous Law College or Affiliated Law Colleges of the University or other medical conditions requiring such assistance to be given to the students as per the opinion of the Students Aid Fund Committee. Provided that the injuries occurring due to the attempt to commit suicide or drunk & drive cases are not covered under this Statute.
- (b) To render such financial assistance or relief, as may be recommended by the Students Aid Fund Committee and approved by the Syndicate, to the relatives of deceased Student. Provided that the death shall have occurred due to the natural causes or sickness or accident occurring within the campus. The death due to suicide is not covered under this Statute.
- (c) In such other cases which the Students Aid Fund Committee deems fit.

5. THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND -

- (1) For the purpose of the administration of the Fund, the University shall constitute a Committee to be called as the 'Students Aid Fund Committee'.
- (2) The Committee shall consist of the following:



 Navanagar, Hubballi-580 025.

6. MAINTENANCE AND UPDATING OF LIST OF THE STUDENTS - The Academic Section of the University shall maintain and update the list of the students and same shall be furnished to Finance Section of the University periodically for information.

7. PROCEDURE FOR AVAILING THE ASSISTANCE -

- (1) A student or his/her relative/s who is/are desirous of availing the assistance under this Statute shall submit an application in the prescribed format along with the necessary documents to the Registrar of the University.
- (2) After the receipt of the application, the Registrar shall forward the same to the Member Secretary of the Committee.
- (3) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall furnish the information of all such applications received under this Statute to the Finance Officer and the Vice-Chancellor.
- (4) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall place all such applications received under this Statute before the Committee for its consideration.

8. THE PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE COMMITTEE -

- (1) The Committee shall evolve the procedure which it deems fit for the purpose of examining the application submitted by a student or his/her relative/s for assistance.
- (2) On receipt of the applications, the Committee shall take appropriate decision with respect to such applications at least within 120 working days from the date of receipt of the application.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may grant extension of 30 days time for the said purpose if there are justifiable reasons.

9. POWERS OF THE COMMITTEE -

- (1) On receipt of the application for assistance, the Committee shall examine the genuineness of claims as per its procedure. Thereafter, it may exercise the powers in following ways:
 - (a) It has to scrutinize the application for examining the genuineness of claims;
 - (b) It may seek further information or documents from the applicant to justify his/her claims and after receipt of same, may take appropriate decision as it may deem fit;

- (c) After scrutiny, if the committee finds that the claims are not genuine or not admissible under the Statute then it may reject the application. The reasons for the rejection of the application shall be communicated to the applicant by the University.
- (d) If the committee finds that the claims are genuine then it may accept the application.
- (e) After accepting the application the committee has to determine the extent of the grant to be given to the applicant. Once it is determined the committee has to prepare a report recommending the extent of grant to be given to the applicant.
- (f) The said report has to be placed before the Syndicate for its approval.
- (g) The Syndicate shall have the power either to accept the recommendations of the committee or modify such recommendations as it may deem fit.
- (h) The decision of the Syndicate in this regard shall be final.
- (i) The University shall issue the order for disbursement of the grant to the applicant in accordance with the approval given by the Syndicate.
- (j) The Committee shall also have the power of taking *suo motto* cognizance of assistance required by any student and same may be placed in its meeting for consideration.
- (k) In relation to the matters taken up *suo motto* by the Committee, it shall have the same powers as mentioned in this Statute.

10. OPERATION OF THE FUND -

- (1) The University shall open a separate Savings Bank Account in any Scheduled Bank paying higher rate of interest in the name of "Karnataka State Law University's Students' Aid Fund".
- (2) This Account shall be operated jointly by and under the signature of the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the University.
- (3) The Member Secretary of the Committee shall maintain separate account book for this Account and submit the annual statements of account before the Committee as and when its meeting is convened.
- (4) The University may deposit the un-utilised amount of this Fund in the fixed deposit in any Scheduled Bank.

II. GRANTS TO THE STUDENTS -

- (1) The Committee, on an application submitted by a student or his/her relative/s or *suo motto*, after being satisfied about the genuineness of the claim, may recommend for grant to be made to the applicant from the Fund -
- (a) In the case of his/her hospitalisation beyond two days or on account of undergoing major surgical operation; or
 - (b) If he/she is suffering from tuberculosis, leprosy, paralysis, cancer, unsoundness of mind or from such other serious disease; or
 - (c) In case a student suffers permanent or partial disability (Physical or mental) on account of accident or otherwise occurring within the campus of Law School, Autonomous Law College or Affiliated Law College of the University.
 - (d) In the event of the death of a student due to sickness or other wise, but does not include death due to suicide. In such event the grant shall be paid in favour of relatives of the deceased student.
 - (e) Injuries occurring during Sports, NSS, NCC, Cultural activities or any other activities organised by the University in its campus.
 - (f) In any other cases of medical treatment undergone by a student. The University may release financial assistance with the approval of the Committee.

Provided, in relation to those students whose relatives avail medical reimbursement from the Government Department or from their institution, the Committee while approving their claim, shall proportionately reduce the grant and then recommend for the payment.

- (2) The recommendations of the Committee in relation to the above matters shall be placed before the Syndicate for its approval.
- (3) The Syndicate shall have the power either to accept the recommendations of the committee or modify such recommendations as it may deem fit.
- (4) The decision of the Syndicate in this regard shall be final.

(5) The University shall issue the order for disbursement of the grant to the applicant in accordance with the approval given by the Syndicate.

Explanation: The Syndicate through its resolution shall have the power to enhance the grants mentioned in the Schedule up to 10% from case to case basis.

12. INTERIM GRANTS BY THE UNIVERSITY

(1) In emergency situations such as immediate hospitalisation, risk to life or in any other exigencies, the University may order for the release of interim grants at such rates as it may deem fit in favour of the student or his/her relative who is in need of the assistance. The University need not wait for the recommendations of the committee in this regard.

(2) Any such interim relief granted by the University has to be placed before the ensuing Syndicate meeting for its ratification.


13. POWER TO INTERPRET - If any question arises as to the interpretation of the provisions of this Statute the decision of the Committee shall be final.

14. SAVINGS CLAUSE - Any action, decision or direction taken or directed by the University under any Statute in force at any time earlier than this Statute coming into force, shall be valid, binding and remain in force notwithstanding anything contained in this Statute.

- B. It was resolved to provide the Traveling Allowances (Train sleeper class/Govt. Bus) and existing DA and other allowances together Rs. 500/- per day for University Blues and KSLU's Law School Students.
- C. Coaches, Managers, Physical Education Directors, Selection Committee Members, Convener, Sports Advisory Committee Members, Director Physical Education etc., Traveling Allowances (III A/C Train or A/C Bus) and existing DA, Honorarium and other allowances together Rs. 1000/- per day.
- D. It was resolved to provide the University Blues the existing Match DA per Student @ Rs. 100 per match for Team Events and @ Rs. 200 for Individual events per heats.
- E. It was resolved to provide the University Blues T-shirts, Shorts, Shoes, socks and Track Suit.

- F. It was resolved to appoint 2 selection committee members from KSLU, one from outside, Director Physical Education of KSLU as Chairman of selection committee and Principal of the host college as the convener to constitute KSLU team to participate in Inter University Tournaments.
- G. It was resolved to appoint one Coach and one Manager for coaching camp and both to escort KSLU Team in Inter University Tournaments.
- H. It was resolved that a maximum of 6 students are permitted to attend the University Blue selection trials from each college.
- I. It was resolved not to levy any entry fees for University Blue Selections.
- J. It was resolved that Physical Education Director of the host college will be the manager for the University team.
- K. It was resolved to provide Badminton Cocks by KSLU for hosting Inter University Selection trials to the host colleges.
- L. It was resolved that University Blue selections to be hosted by the organizers of Intercollegiate tournaments including Cricket.
- M. It was resolved to provide the Students securing 01st to 08th Place in All India Inter University Athletic Competition and students secured 01st to 04th Place in individual events an award of Rs. 1,00,000/- for each Student.
- N. It was resolved to continue to provide the teams securing 1st to 4th place, in Inter University Tournament in Team events an awarded of Rs. 2,00,000/- to be distributed equally among Students, Coach & Manager.

It was resolved that in case some extraordinary students want to participate in the individual events and team events which are not covered in the Para No. 2 (A), a committee of two Sports Advisory Committee Members, one event specialized expert and Director Physical Education along with the higher authorities will take a decision to send the team.

3. POINT SYSTEM:

- It was resolved to continue the existing Point System Rules of the previous year.
- a) First, Second and Third place cash prize winners of each year will not get any cash award for next three years, but ranking will be awarded.
 - b) The existing Slab points for standard and quality of sports 1000, 900 & 800 points for First, Second & Third places respectively.
 - c) No slab for Fourth to Sixth place.
 - d) 20 negative points for the absence of Managers.
 - e) 50 negative points for an indiscipline team.

- f) 3 years ban for inclusion of other than registered college students or Indiscipline.
- g) Each team participating in Intercollegiate Meet, Men and Women events will be awarded 25 points each.
- h) Winning Team in Intercollegiate will get 20 points.
- i) Runners up in Intercollegiate will get 15 points.
- j) Third place in Intercollegiate will get 10 points.
- k) Fourth place in Intercollegiate will get 5 points.
- l) Physical Education Director/Manager escorting the team will be awarded 20 points
- m) University Blue per student will get 25 points each.
- n) Hosting the Intercollegiate Meet 25 points for men and 25 points for women.
- o) Hosting the Selection trails will get 25 points each for Men and Women.
- p) Attending the University selection Trails will get 10 points per student.
- q) KSLU's Law School, Navanagar, Hubballi is exempted from the cash award.
- r) Trophies & certificates will be issued for First to Sixth Ranks.
- s) To distribute Sports Equipments to the winners/Ranked Colleges in Point system for the academic year from 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 by inviting E-Tender existing amount per year as shown below.

- d. It was resolved that host college will provide Food & Accommodation to all the participants and managers. The University shall bear these expenses as per norms.
- e. It was resolved that Medals, Trophy's and Certificates will be provided by KSLU for Intercollegiate competition.
- f. It was resolved that each college must participate in at least 5 Intercollegiate Tournaments.
- g. It was resolved to provide existing per day boarding and lodging charges per student + manager per day Rs. 250 to be paid to the host colleges who conduct Intercollegiate Tournaments.
- h. It was resolved to provide existing amount for expenditure Rs. 15,000/- to colleges which organize Intercollegiate Competitions.
- i. It was resolved to enhance the amount from Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 75,000/- to the college which conduct Intercollegiate Cricket Tournament.
- j. It was resolved to give advance amount of Rs. 25,000/- to colleges which organize intercollegiate competitions and Rs. 50,000/- for college which conduct Intercollegiate Cricket tournament.
- k. It was resolved that the Host College should arrange a clinic in their respective Game at the existing honorarium of Rs. 1,000/- to be borne.
- l. It was resolved that Intercollegiate Athletic Meet will be held in at KSLU.


5. GENERAL:

- a. It was resolved to provide existing Rs. 100/- as local conveyance charges for each student, Coach, Manager, Selection Committee Members, Convener, Sports Advisory Committee Members, Physical Education Directors, Director Physical Education, and all other officers and students authorized by KSLU.
- b. It was resolved to reserve one seat for sports quota in Admission for Law Courses. Proposal will be submitted to KSLU for considering one percentage.
- c. It was resolved to provide a Trophy or Cash prize for the best outgoing Male and Female Sports person at Intercollegiate Athletic Meet every year.
- d. It was resolved to obtain consent of Parents and Principals of students for participants in competition.
- e. It was resolved to provide Insurance for the University Blues participating in competitions, by their respective college principals.

- f. It was resolved to permit Director, Physical Education of KSLU to attend all the Intercollegiate tournaments and University team selection trials and to assist a Junior Assistant from Sports Section to be permitted. TA / DA as per KSLU norms.
- g. It was resolved to host National Conference in Sports at KSLU.

- B. It was resolved to provide the Traveling Allowances (Train sleeper class/Govt. Bus) and existing DA and other allowances together Rs. 500/- per day for University Blues and KSLU's Law School Students.
- C. Coaches, Managers, Physical Education Directors, Selection Committee Members, Convener, Sports Advisory Committee Members, Director Physical Education etc., Traveling Allowances (III A/C Train or A/C Bus) and existing DA, Honorarium and other allowances together Rs. 1000/- per day.
- D. It was resolved to provide the University Blues the existing Match DA per Student @ Rs. 100 per match for Team Events and @ Rs. 200 for Individual events per heats.

- a) First, Second and Third place cash prize winners of each year will not get any cash award for next three years, but ranking will be awarded.
 - b) The existing Slab points for standard and quality of sports 1000, 900 & 800 points for First, Second & Third places respectively.
 - c) No slab for Fourth to Sixth place.
 - d) 20 negative points for the absence of Managers.
 - e) 50 negative points for an indiscipline team.

- f) 3 years ban for inclusion of other than registered college students or Indiscipline.
- g) Each team participating in Intercollegiate Meet, Men and Women events will be awarded 25 points each.
- h) Winning Team in Intercollegiate will get 20 points.
- i) Runners up in Intercollegiate will get 15 points.
- j) Third place in Intercollegiate will get 10 points.
- k) Fourth place in Intercollegiate will get 5 points.
- l) Physical Education Director/Manager escorting the team will be awarded 20 points
- m) University Blue per student will get 25 points each.
- n) Hosting the Intercollegiate Meet 25 points for men and 25 points for women.
- o) Hosting the Selection trails will get 25 points each for Men and Women.
- p) Attending the University selection Trails will get 10 points per student.
- q) KSLU's Law School, Navanagar, Hubballi is exempted from the cash award.
- r) Trophies & certificates will be issued for First to Sixth Ranks.
- s) To distribute Sports Equipments to the winners/Ranked Colleges in Point system for the academic year from 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 by inviting E-Tender existing amount per year as shown below.

4. INTERCOLLEGIATE:

- a. It was resolved to continue to provide the athletes who create new records in Athletic meet a cash award of Rs 5000/- .In case many athletes break the record, only the person securing First place will be rewarded.
- b. It was resolved to continue to provide the Best Male and Female Athlete in Athletic Meet with a cash award of Rs 10,000/- each. In case of tie, the same amount shall be shared.

- c. It was resolved not to levy any entry fees for Intercollegiate Tournaments.
- d. It was resolved that host college will provide Food & Accommodation to all the participants and managers. The University shall bear these expenses as per norms.
- e. It was resolved that Medals, Trophy's and Certificates will be provided by KSLU for Intercollegiate competition.
- f. It was resolved that each college must participate in at least 5 Intercollegiate Tournaments.
- g. It was resolved to provide existing per day boarding and lodging charges per student + manager per day Rs. 250 to be paid to the host colleges who conduct Intercollegiate Tournaments.
- h. It was resolved to provide existing amount for expenditure Rs. 15,000/- to colleges which organize Intercollegiate Competitions.
- i. It was resolved to enhance the amount from Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 75,000/- to the college which conduct Intercollegiate Cricket Tournament.
- j. It was resolved to give advance amount of Rs. 25,000/- to colleges which organize intercollegiate competitions and Rs. 50,000/- for college which conduct Intercollegiate Cricket tournament.
- k. It was resolved that the Host College should arrange a clinic in their respective Game at the existing honorarium of Rs. 1,000/- to be borne.
- l. It was resolved that Intercollegiate Athletic Meet will be held in at KSLU.
- m. It was resolved to provide T-shirt, Shorts, Caps, TA, Accommodation, Local Transportation, Good Nutrition food such as Milk, Egg, Fruits and quality Break Fast, Lunch and Dinner during the Intercollegiate Athletic Meet and 'AT HOME' special dinner by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.


5. GENERAL:
