Sub: adoption of government schools for development by universities  
Ref: Hon'ble Prime Minister's initiative - VIDYANJALI

Your kind attention is drawn to the state governments drive to leverage quality of school education through adoption for development. I am pleased to mention that Sri B.S. Yediyurappa, the then hon'ble chief minister, government of Karnataka accepted my recommendation to make budgetary declaration (2020-21) that all the MLAs adopt 03 schools each and develop them as model schools over a period of time. This scheme is now extended to include the other elected representatives viz., MLCs (03 schools each) and MPs including Rajya sabha members (05 schools each) as well as 35/50 universities in the state (10 schools each). Honb'le chief minister has also launched the scheme officially on 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 and distributed adoption certificates to all the ministers and Chancellors/Vice Chancellors/Directors of autonomous colleges. This initiative is first of its kind in the country and has received all-round appreciation.

Similarly, the present CM Sri Basavaraj Bommai has reappointed me as Adviser, Education Reforms w.e.f. 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 and assured me all governmental help to reimagine government schools in Karnataka.

Given the large number of government schools which require support in one form or the other (about 30,000/48,000), the scope of the scheme needs to be enlarged with more philanthropists and educational institutions adopting government schools for development.

It is in this regard, I write this letter on behalf of the state government to participate in the programme by adopting 10 government schools and develop them. For this purpose, 22 developmental priorities have already been identified, to be implemented in 2 phases i.e., Phase-I (15 infrastructure priorities) and Phase-II (7 academic priorities). It is noteworthy that the National Education Policy 2020 also promotes higher educational institutions to support school education in a big way.

**Relevant Sections of NEP to Vidyanjali-2**

**Section 10.5.** In addition to teaching and research, HEIs will also have other crucial responsibilities, which they will discharge through appropriate resourcing and structures. These include supporting other HEIs in their development, community engagement and service, contribution to various fields of practice, faculty development for the higher education system, and support to school education.

**Section 15.8.** The faculty in Departments of Education shall have not only PhDs in education but also those without PhD but having outstanding teaching experience/field experience; and those with training in areas of social sciences that are directly relevant to school education (e.g., psychology, child development, linguistics, sociology, philosophy/political science) as well as from science education, mathematics education, social science education, and language education.

In view of the above, I earnestly request your esteemed institution to adopt 05 government school in the vicinity and help the government to leverage school education services in the state. Your institution also will be highly rewarded with the distinction of participating in a meaningful extension activity of national importance – school education being fundamental to development of students as future productive citizen.

The concerned BEO and/or DDPI will be instructed to meet your esteemed self with a list of government schools which need your support.

Meanwhile, kindly send a consent letter by mail or letter to my office for taking the matter to the next level of affirmative action.

## RECOMMENDATIONS MADE TO THE STATE GOVERNMENT :

### 1 Adoption of Government Schools for Development by MLAs, MLCs and MPs

State government is constrained by inadequate resources to meet the ever growing demand for good quality schools, as most of the allocated funds are consumed by salaries. As an alternative, adoption of government schools by philanthropists / private institutions has become a well established practice. In Karnataka, PES University has played a key role to nucleate an initiative since 1991 and later in association with Sri Govinde Gowda, the then minister for Primary and Secondary Education, not only to formulate a cohesive state policy for the first time in 2001 but also developed 16 government schools of Bangalore urban and rural areas.



The 2001 policy was updated by a GO in 2009 to formalize the participation of donors/ philanthropists through an MoU wherein the donor-participant can select school/s and a plan of action in selected areas open for their development (see DPI website). Although, the programme is successful, there still exists enormous scope to expand it further to reach out to uncovered issues and areas. For instance, more than half the private participation comes from the coastal districts of Mangalore and Udupi. Thus, a pressing need to develop schools in underdeveloped and disaster prone areas of the state emerges as a future focus. It is noteworthy that PES University has developed / constructed 10 schools in flood ravaged areas of Chikkodi and Bagalkot districts in 2019.

The intended transformation could happen if adoption policy is redefined to set a novel stage for empowering school system as a whole. A multi-dimensional roadmap of such a set up is given below:

1. **Legislators taking a lead role** would galvanize the support of other stakeholders, transforming the initiative into a social movement over a period of time.
  - a. They could select 3 government schools in their assembly constituency for focused development in their tenure of 5 years. Thus, 675 government schools could be covered under the scheme.
  - b. The scheme has also been extended to include Members of Legislative Council so that  $(75 \times 3)$  225 more government schools are added, taking the total to 900.
  - c. Members of Parliament from the State (both Loka Sabha and Rajya Sabha) have also joined the initiative with 05 schools each, the total goes up by another 160.

d. Thus, a total of  $675+225+160 = 1060$  schools could be developed in a single electoral term of 5/6 years

2. **Existing Institutions of Higher Learning** could take the initiative further by adopting government schools in their vicinity, as mentioned below:

- a. State universities – 10 schools
- b. Private/Deemed universities – 10 schools
- c. Medical colleges – 10 schools
- d. Engineering colleges – 05 to 10 schools
- e. Dental colleges – 05 schools
- f. UG/PG/Autonomous Colleges – 03
- g. PU colleges – 02

Due to personal intervention by the Adviser, 24 Universities (state and private) have already adopted 10 schools each.

3. **For New Institutions**, the government may henceforth include stipulations cited in 2 (a-g) above as preconditions. In this regard, Adviser has already recommended that adoption of government schools should be one of the pre-conditions to sanction a new education institution; the number of schools to be adopted should be as indicated in para (3) above.

4. **Participation of Corporate/Industry/Philanthropists** could take the initiative to the next level. They could:

- a. Adopt a school under the existing scheme for:
  - development of academic infrastructure (computers, library, scholarships, ICT teaching=learning technology empowerment etc.,)
  - physical infrastructure (additional class rooms, compound, toilets for boys and girls, furniture, computers etc.)

b. In addition to (a) above, they could participate in construction and management of an entire school

c. At the time of this report going to press, a total of 1414 government schools have been adopted by MLAs, MLC, MPs, Rajyasabha members, 25 Universities (State and Private), 3 autonomous colleges. Efforts are on to invite 200 important IT companies to participate in this programme in a big way. Success would mean a huge boost to the government's school adoption policy.

5. the donor-participants may also contribute, either by funds or in kind, to construct new schools under a special scheme contemplated on the basis of NEP,

as below:







- **Level 1:** construct physical infrastructure for preschool 1-3 years
- **Level 2:** construct physical infrastructure for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> standard
- **Level 3:** construct physical infrastructure for 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standard
- **Level 4:** construct physical infrastructure for 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> standard

The salient features of the expanded scheme are as below:

- a. Constructions should be in accordance with a government approved plan for levels 1 to 4, to maintain uniformity, monitor cost effectiveness and identity across the state
- b. The architecture should inspire the students with a focus on the academic ambience including well planned: class rooms, academic infrastructure, staff space, library, safety measures, compound, toilets (separate for girls and boys), safe drinking water, power and indoor games/athletics.
- c. Donors may choose any or all the four levels for participation in localities/ locations of their choice or those prioritized by the government such as disaster prone areas or socially, educationally backward areas across the state and gram panchayats as per the draft report of the designated planning commission committee of education.
- d. The government may consider a special provision for the newly constructed school to carry the name of the Donor as a mark of appreciation and acknowledgment.

This initiative emerges from the Government's deep concern to create an education system that extends equal opportunity for all, not a privileged few individuals or areas. It is proposed to expand the number of good/model schools across the state by enlisting the participation of all stakeholders with targeted outcomes of increased Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) and good quality educational services. It is sincerely hoped that over the years the school adoption scheme in its new Avatar would benefit the intertwined future of both the students and the government.

In the entire exercise, it should be noted that there are about 48,000 government schools in the state with millions of students; most of them belong to socially and educationally less advanced sections of society. It is therefore fundamentally important to empower them through quality education and enable them to join the main stream of society as independent and productive citizen.

To scale up such an inspirational scheme as a social movement, the government as the regulatory stakeholder has to demonstrate its intentions to go beyond technologies and MoUs for building physical infrastructure, to put in place a school system responsive to the aspirations of the community. However daunting it may appear, this journey has to be undertaken and the challenges have to be met in the best interests of





students and the country.

Once successful, it would provide a model worthy of emulation by other states.

### Relevance to NEP:

NEP sets an ambitious target of achieving 50% GER at all levels by 2050. This target is achievable provided that both the union and state governments mobilize resources to increase the number of government schools as well as support them to deliver the high quality services expected of them.

As in most states, Karnataka also faces resources crunch, with most of the budget allocation for primary & secondary education spent on salaries and maintenance. As a compensatory measure, the state government has launched a 'School Adoption Scheme' under which provisions for participation by philanthropists, industry and corporate houses under PPP/CSR.

NEP also supports such community participation and plans to launch pilot projects under Public-Private Partnership and a novel Philanthropic-Public Partnership channels (section 3: Curtailing school dropouts and universal access to education at all levels)

Section 3.6. To make it easier for both governments as well as non-governmental philanthropic organizations to build schools, to encourage local variations on account of culture, geography, and demographics, and to allow alternative models of education, such as gurukulas, pathshaalas, madarasas, and home schooling, the requirements for schools will be made less restrictive. The focus will be to have less emphasis on input and greater emphasis on output potential concerning desired learning outcomes. Regulations on inputs will be limited to ensuring safety of children (both physical and psychological), access and inclusion, the nonprofit nature of schools, and minimum standards for learning outcomes.

### Analytical Comments:

Seeds for the State school adoption policy were sown in 1980s with some philanthropists and institutions developing schools in their vicinity. Policy formulation exercises by the government initiated in early 2000s and took a definite shape in 2011 with elaborate provisions for participation of individual philanthropic organizations, PPP/CSR by industries and corporate houses; such participations are acknowledged by the government by way of bilateral MoUs. Although, the government has achieved considerable success over the past years, philanthropic participation is restricted to certain geographical areas to the exclusion of other areas. For example, > 50% of the funds collected under the scheme come from coastal districts of Mangalore, Udupi and Uttara Kannada, Geographically disadvantaged areas like Kalyana Karnataka and other similar areas have not attracted the attention of philanthropists. This concern needs to be addressed by the remodeled policy recommendation with due weightage for





equity and social justice. Details of the scheme are available on the website of Department of Public Instruction, GoK.

My recommendation to the state government for all MLAs to adopt 3 government schools in their respective constituencies has been included in the state budget for 2020-21, thus taking the initiative to implementation level even before the pilot projects envisaged by NEP. The programmatic affirmative actions taken in this regard are mentioned below:

- a. The existing state government school adoption policy (2011) has been tweaked to add more value
- b. From this exercise has emerged a novel dimension of MLAs adopting government schools. This measure is based on the concept that by an important legislative functionary like an MLA leading the school development programmes, it would naturally attract the community and potential philanthropists to come forward to participate.
- c. Honble Chief Minister has approved my recommendation to include all the MLCs and MPs from Karnataka (including Rajya Sabha members) ; Chief Minister has written to MLCs and MPs to adopt 3/5 government schools each for development in their respective constituencies
- d. Criterion for selection of a school for adoption is its acute needs to function as an independent educational institution (physical infrastructure, library, safe drinking water, toilets – separate for boys and girls, class rooms as per requirement. Teachers as per requirement, library, digitization- computers, smart boards etc., compound, repairs and painting and ambience).
- e. My recommended policy further extends to participation of all education institutions as explained below:
  - i. Universities to adopt 10 government schools in their jurisdiction
  - ii. Colleges – 5 schools
  - iii. Medical Colleges/Engineering Colleges – 5 schools

A university participating in the adoption programme has great advantages to the schools as it could leverage academic aspects such as training school teachers in languages, science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Environmental Science), social science, general knowledge, moral education etc., In addition, thematic workshops, Knowledge Festivals, organize performing arts, sports and essay writing/debate competitions etc.

In essence a university/HEI is envisaged as a 'Friend, Philosopher and Guide' to the adopted schools in their overall development.

These aspects are also substantiated in the recommendations of the NEP wherein the





HEIs are envisaged as the academic leader of the school complex /cluster system, furthering their development.

It is noteworthy that 2 of my other recommendations on Clusters and Mentoring, which have significant bearing on the success of school adoption programme; these two recommendations are also important recommendations of NEP

Sincere efforts are on to further extend the scope of the school adoption policy by involving leading philanthropists of the state/country, captains of leading industries, corporates and organizations for capacity building of school education system.

### **Recommendations:**

1. Given the strong support by NEP under three major recommendations viz., community participation (CSR-PPP & Philanthropic-Public Participation), Mentoring and Clusters, government should immediately initiate steps to facilitate school adoption by MLAs and institutional participation as detailed in my recommendations.

Note: Please read chapters on Mentoring and Clusters to get an overview of their synergizing influence on school education and student welfare.

6. Jointly organize professional training for Medical Practitioners, Advocates, Prosecutors, etc.
7. Jointly organize seminars, symposia, workshops, etc.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### PREAMBLE

The National Law School of India University (NLSIU) University, Bangalore, established under National Law School of India Act (Karnataka Act 22 of 1986) in 1987 with the Chief Justice of India as its Chancellor, is the first and the only law university fully supported by the Bar Council of India and the Bench. One of the main objectives of NLSIU is to 'bring legal education on par with other professional courses like medicine and engineering, where a student fresh out of high-school can make an immediate career choice'. The NLSIU has been conducting a strong B.A., LL.B.(Hons.), LL.M., M.Phil., Ph.D. and LL.D. programs in all Social Sciences and Law. The NLSIU has made strides in teaching the law courses with both interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary dimensions and facilitating research and publication on those lines since its establishment.

The Karnataka State Law University (KSLU), Hubballi, was established in January, 2009, by the Government of Karnataka under the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009, with its headquarters at Navanagar, Hubballi. It is a 'People's University' with an aspiration to provide quality legal education totally socially relevant and accessible to everyone. The KSLU, located in the State of Karnataka, is the single largest federal university in the country having 107 colleges under its umbrella.

**Whereas,** KSLU desires to establish academic collaboration with Institutions of excellence in Social Sciences in the country and NLSIU is one among such recognized institutions and seeks to promote the institutional collaborations through this Memorandum of Understanding.



## SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the NLSIU as First Party and KSLU as Second Party for the purpose of Academic Collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and publication. In addition to this, active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following.

### I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION:

1. NLSIU and KSLU shall collaborate in mutually agreeable academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts;
2. The Ph.D. candidates in interdisciplinary areas of research involving law from the Karnataka State Law University shall work under the supervision of the faculty members of NLSIU or if agreed, jointly supervised by the faculty members from the two parties;
3. Faculty members from each of these universities shall be invited for important seminars, conferences and for teaching at P.G. and doctoral level. The financial implications shall be worked out on a case to case basis;
4. Those modalities for a similar exchange of researchers and faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussion that should be made operational for a period of five years;





5. Ph.D. Scholars of both the Universities are welcome to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty;
6. Research Scholars and Teaching Faculty of both NLSIU and KSLU will explore possibility of taking up collaborative research work and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments and other funding agencies;
7. Any financial implication emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students etc.) shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreement.

## II. AREAS OF COOPERATION

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by NLSIU and KSLU to cooperate in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by written consent of the two parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

## III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by giving six months written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.



#### IV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

1. In respect of each project and programme the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents, designs and confidential information pertaining thereto).
2. Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing.

The confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

#### V. NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM


Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.



## VI. TERMINATION

1. This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.
2. The validity of the Memorandum of Understanding is for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institutions.
