These authorities give free legal aid to a person if he/she is not capable of bearing the expenditure. This includes appointing a lawyer in case the person is a defendant in a case. He suggested law students to set goals and work towards providing justice to the society.

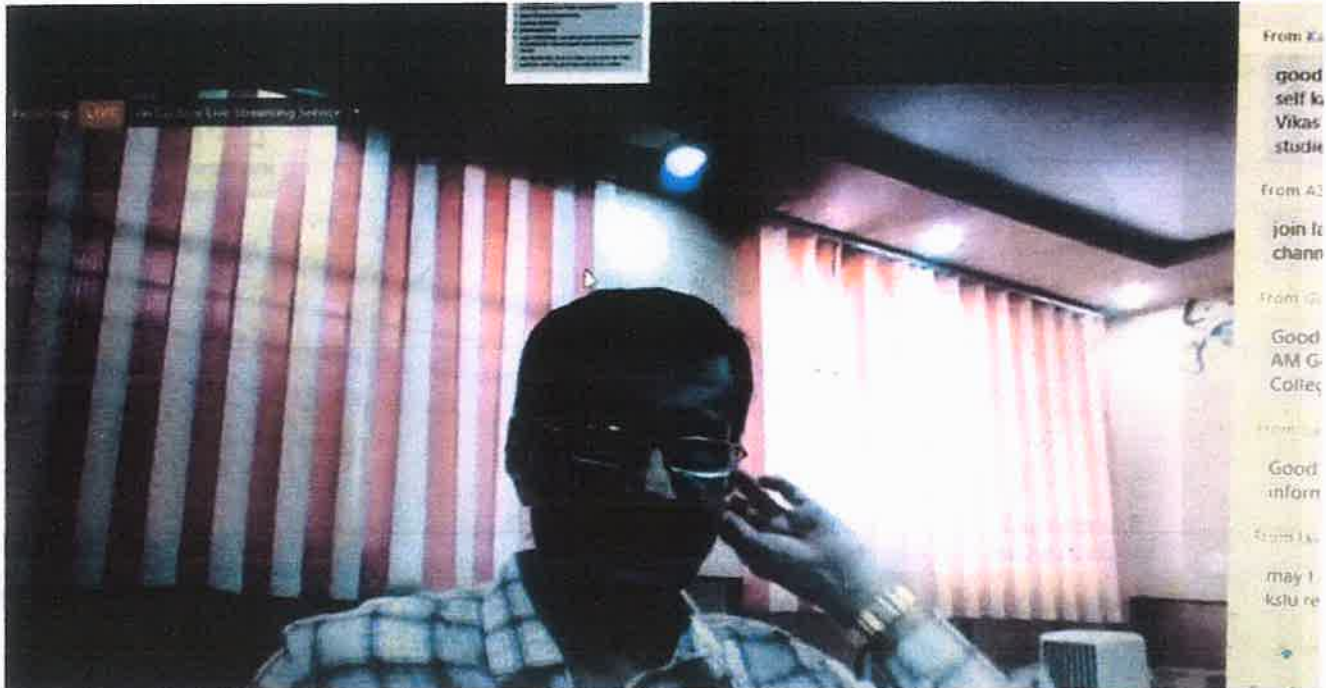

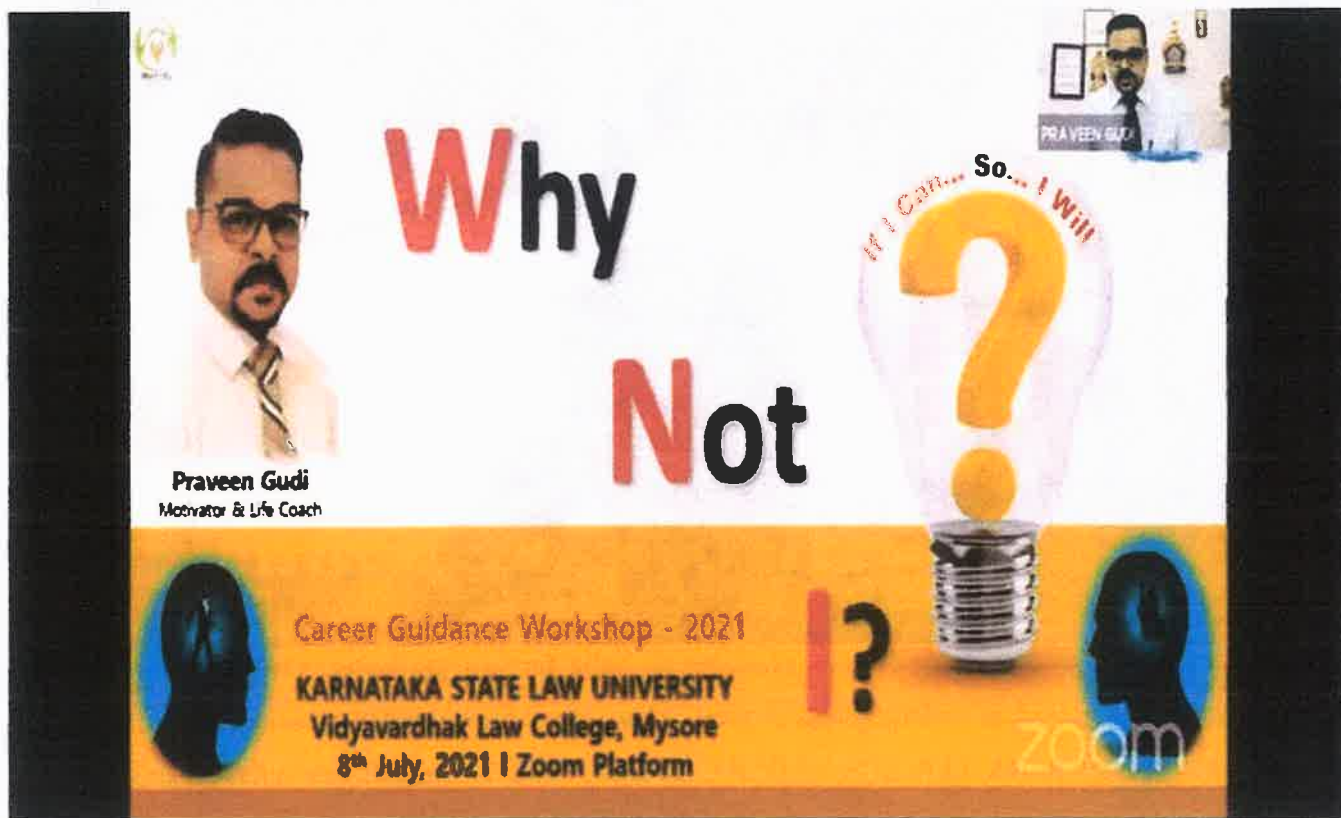
- Judiciary

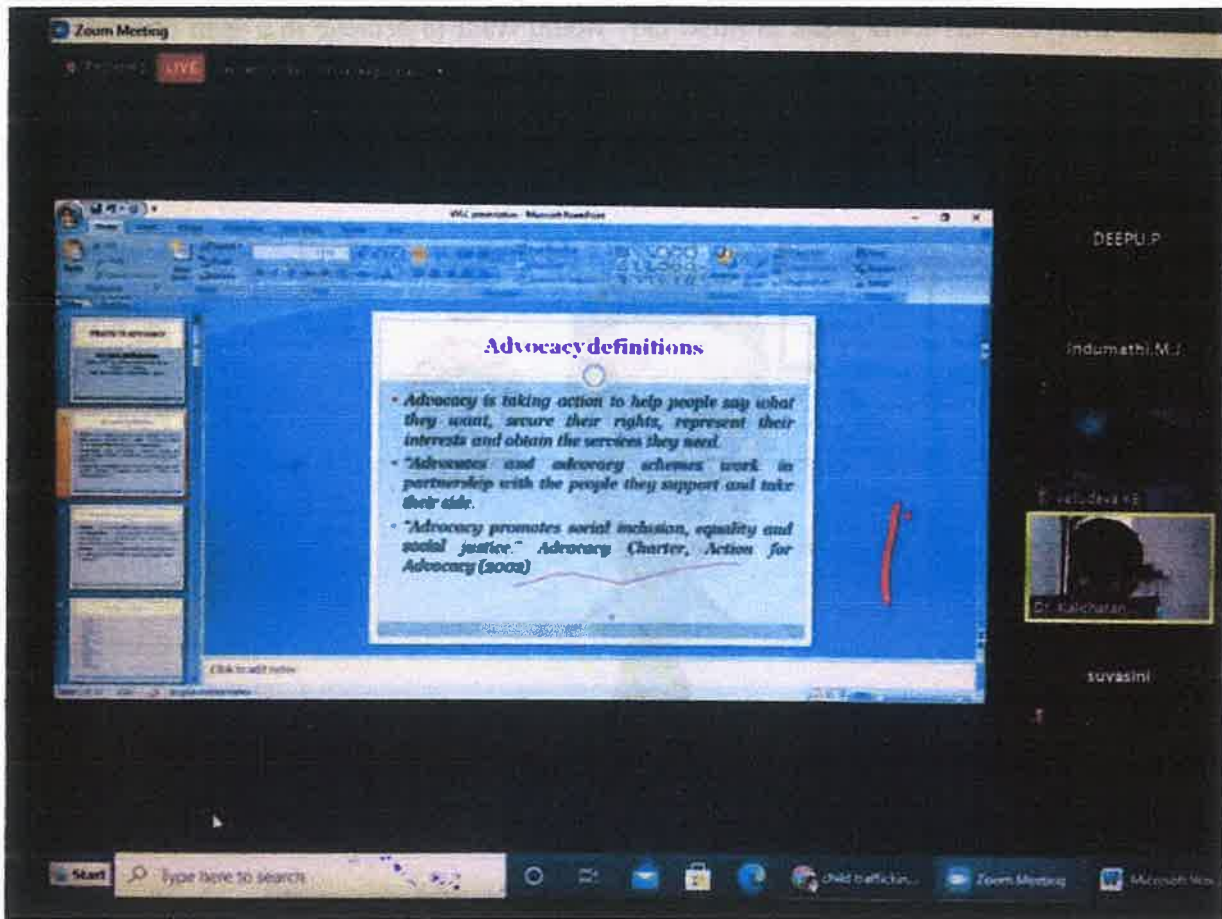

In the Third Session Dr. Kalicharan, Principal, Vidyavikas of legal studies Mysore spoke on TRAITS OF ADVOCACY



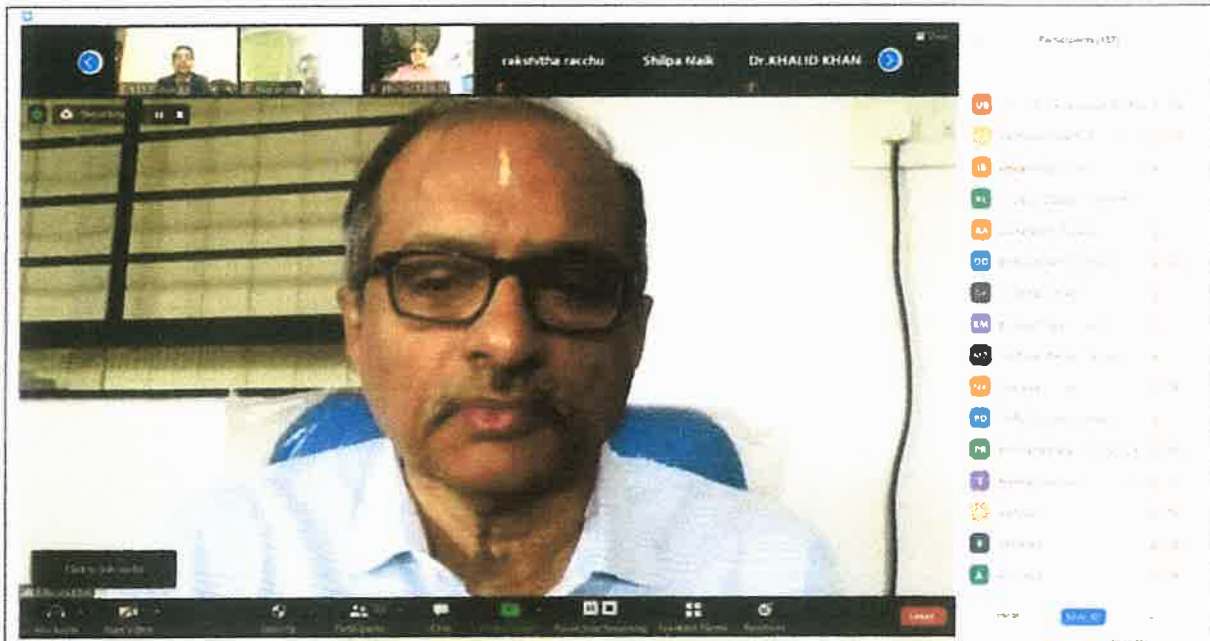

REPORT ON 'CAREER GUIDANCE WORKSHOP' ORGANISED BY
KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY

An exclusive Workshop on career guidance was organized by the Karnataka State Law University in association with Bengaluru Law College to give guidance to all the law students of 21 Law Colleges of Bangalore Zone 1 . The workshop scheduled on 5th July 2021 Monday at 10.00am . The session was inaugurated by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof.(Dr) P.Ishwara Bhat , who emphasized all the Law Colleges for their high spirit and continuous efforts of imparting education even during the lockdown through online teaching. Sir welcomed all the esteemed speakers on and off the virtual dais. Three eminent speakers namely Hon'ble Justice Ram Mohan Reddy, Former Judge, High Court of Karnataka, Prof(Dr) Venkata Rao, Chairman VILLS and Former VC NLSIU and Rev.Fr.Emmanuel, Director, Kristu Jayanthi College of Law, Bangalore. The workshop was witnessed by various principals, faculties, scholars and students.

Sir further threw light on the fact that Law Schools should now be prepared to ensure safety and good health of students. He further encouraged all Law students to enhance their knowledge to enter into the career which will support themselves, family as well as the society by giving the rightful knowledge of law. He advised principals of all the law colleges to conduct career guidance

workshops, trainings, and also encourage in learning practical skill training and policy making programs. He also stressed upon Compulsory internship for law students to undergo for 40 days which can give wider exposure for their practical learning and their future career.

Our respected Principal Prof.Devika.S.Ajila, is thankful for giving opportunity to Bengaluru Law College and also the valuable inputs delivered by Prof.(Dr) P.Ishwara Bhat, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Karnataka State Law University.

- **1st Session started at 10.30am by Hon'ble Justice Ram Mohan Reddy, Former Judge, High Court of Karnataka, who delivered lecture on Communication skills and its Significance .**
- Hon'ble Justice Sir spoke about the Communication skills which is very important in for their success in their career. Sir also guided on how a student should transform his attitude so that he can gain confidence, competence and success. The important qualities like integrity, dedication and perseverance which are the guiding force for success. Justice emphasized more on how to acquire knowledge of law. Only knowledge in law can help a person to become a better human and that is possible through proper communication. Justice discussed various types of communications which is important in the field of law specially in court. Usage of communication without legal language is drawback in profession.


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

Justice also spoke on listening capability of an advocate. Over all there was lot of important inputs for the skills in the field of law that must be inculcated in the initial stages for successful career.

- **2nd Session started at 11.30am by Prof(Dr.) Venkata Rao, Chairman VILLS, and Former Vice Chancellor, NLSIU who spoke on Career Prospects in Law .**

Sir spoke on various types of alternative resolution mechanism available in litigation and students must have aquatinted with the same. Sir gave a glimpse on various specializations in law in the recent trends available for the beginners to opt like space law, cyber law, company law, sports law etc. Pro bono advocacy is important for the freshers. The globalization has impacted the field of law where lawyers have to get accessed with legal technologies and legal instruments for choosing their career. But professional ethics must not be forgotten once a student starts his career. Sir also recommended reading few books of Authors like Richard Suskind and Daniel Suskind.

- **3rd Session started at 12.30pm by Rev.Fr.Emmanuel, Director, Kristu Jayanthi College of Law, Bangalore on Personality Development Skills and its Relevance in Profession**
- Sir, spoke on the skills for the development of one's personality. Sir being a psychologist enlightened us about the human behaviors and how these behaviors can give success in


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career. Sir in his PowerPoint presentation explained in detail about the inputs to students as what makes a good lawyer like the combination of characteristics or qualities that form an individual's distinctive character and individual differences in characteristic patterns of thinking, feeling and behaving. Sir also made it significant for the law students to duties of lawyer is not only to clients but duties towards society, court and opponents. Credible quality has to be present in a lawyer to make difference with others in the society. Further he advised more than hard working, it must be smart working where each individual should stick on the goals. Failures in the career have to be addressed by thinking critically where we are going wrong. Fear should be removed to have goals achieved. With all these he advised 8 zones, colleges to provide one week translation classes (14 lectures), Kannada to English and vice versa for both 3 & 5 Years Law students, for which KSLU would give financial assistance, with soft skills, you tube videos, to make our rural background students comfortable in global language. It is an exclusive program for law students in this pandemic situation.

Followed by inaugural speech, Chief Guest Sri. Venkatesh Naik. T, was introduced by Dr. Kariyanna. K.S. Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga.

Chief Guest spoke about advantages of law course in both individual and social perspectives. A lawyer should posses special strategy while arguing, interviewing and supporting the clients, preparing legal documents and conducting legal research are core factors to be progressive. In forthcoming years job opportunities are more optimistic, law firm practice is more nowadays, which brings rapid growth for determined mindsets. MNC's opened independent legal departments in their premises, which are useful in public interest.

Career opportunities are more in both public and private sector. There are many chances in non profit organization, immigration and labour disputes, standing council of the state, writing and interpreting in criminal and civil cases, firms, finance, tax, banking, KPSC recruitment as PP's etc. To encourage the young advocates state government providing Rs. 2,000/- as stipend for 2 years, which is very useful for their practice tenure. This profession gives job satisfaction and security. Self learning is most important but priority should be given to long term aspiration. Morality and Swadharma has to be maintained even at the cost of life. Of course, the path is not bed of roses but nothing is impossible if the fighter is strong enough. Respecting each other, takes us towards glory otherwise incapable, apart from all these young generation have to maintain distance from time being attractions and distractions, in this competitive world everyone should be progressive thinker because humanity is ultimate in all aspects.

At the end of inaugural session Smt. Archana. K. Assistant Professor and Co-ordinator of the workshop, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi proposed the vote of thanks to all the dignitaries, principals, faculty and students. Smt. Harsha. S.M , Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College managed and performed the responsibility of master of ceremony proactively.

Resource Person Miss Sheela Adaveeshaiah spoke on "Career opportunities in legal field". She focused on the traditional glory of the profession and gave glimpses of current opportunities in public and private sector, in India and Abroad. She explained about various U.G, P.G, Diploma, Certificate Courses, Research possibilities in subjects like Human Rights, Labour Law, Cyber Law, Business, Aviation, space and telecommunications, animal protection, medical and paramedical fortuities and integrated courses.

Law graduates and post graduates can get space as legal officers, litigation and non-litigation position, law associate or as partner, academicians, LIC, National Insurance Companies, Stocks, shares and security and in Army judge Advocate General jobs without any gender discrimination. Fortuity as advisors to trusts and NGO's, service sector, healthcare sector, real estate, information technology, legal officers, legal journalists, legal content developer in film industry, website reviewing profession, those who are interested in writing can avail both name and fame, and can appear in many competitive examination like CLAT, IPBS, SSB, UPSC, KPSC and Clerical cadre to judge level position.

Another Maven Prof. (Dr.) Sairam bhat articulated on the topic "Higher Education Opportunities in Abroad". Initially he defined the advantages between Under Graduation and Post Graduation regarding the learning process and maturity of every individual. He also brief the necessity and the scope of English as universal language, especially when we quest for Higher Education in Abroad. Because they focus on method practice, perception will be more and practical rather than unwanted theories. Since learning the law never stops, formal learning, self preparation, interviewing more in advance compare to our traditional methodology. If an individual need to help or solve the problems of foreign clients, he must possess competency of International/foreign Arbitration. Higher Education in Abroad not only provide the job and income, meanwhile it modifies the lifestyle, networking, merit based learning make aspirants proficiency in both written and spoken etiquette.


