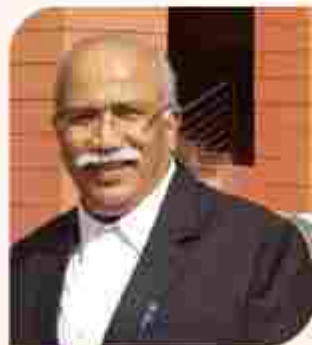

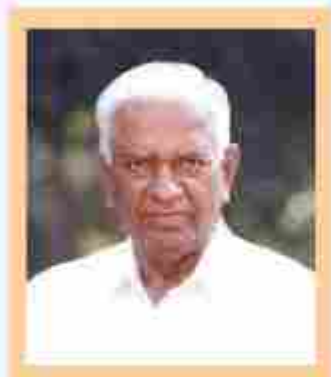

The Chairperson welcomed all the members of the Board of Studies.

The members of the Board deliberated on agenda item elaborately and resolved as under:

Agenda 1. Introduction of Major-Minor Subjects for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programme.

The Board members elaborately discussed the benefits of adopting the Major-Minor system for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programme. It was felt that the system has certain benefits which the students enrolled for B.A., LL.B. Programme in Affiliated Law Colleges are bestowed with. It was considered opinion of the members that, the same benefits should be available to the students of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programme also. After due deliberations on the directions of the University Authorities to introduce History as Major subject, Economics and Political Science as Minor subjects was appreciated and approved.

After thorough discussion, the Board considered and approved the syllabus of 6 Papers of History as Major subject and 3 papers for each of Economics and Political Science as Minor subjects of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programme.

For B.B.A., LL.B.(Hon's) programme the Board considered and approved to include Business Statistics in place of Quantitative Techniques which is to be studied in Fifth Semester for B.B.A., LL.B.(Hon's) programme.

After this the allocation of subjects to various semester of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programmes were meticulously considered. To quench the thirst of students to study the Law subjects in the initial semester itself and also to integrate Law subjects with foundation subjects, the Board resolved to perlocate the subjects to be studied in Ten semesters of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hon's) Programme.

After intense discussion, the Law subjects and Non Law Subjects to be taught in Ten Semesters for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Programmes were finalized.

Resolution: It was resolved to introduce History as Major subject with 6 papers, Economics and Political Science as Minor subjects with 3 papers each with the syllabus as appended in Appendix - I (History 6 papers, Economics 3papers and Political Science 3papers)

For B.B.A.,LL.B.(Hons) programme it was resolved to include Business Statistics in place of Quantitative Techniques which is to be studied in Fifth Semester of the Programme.

Further it was resolved to adopt the reallocation of subjects to be studied in Ten semesters as appended for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Appendix - II and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Appendix - III.

Agenda 2: Revising of the syllabus

Law being a dynamic subject undergoes periodic changes to meet the requirement of the society. The curriculum and syllabus of the B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) programmes should be updated to incorporate the developments whenever necessary.

To undertake this exercise in a systematic manner in consultation with various stake holders, different subjects were allotted to teachers as shown in Appendix - IV to undertake initial spade work for revising the Syllabus.

As a first step the revised syllabus for the I Semester of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) were approved as appended in Appendix - V and Appendix - VI respectively.

Resolution: It was resolved to adopt the revised syllabus as appended in Appendix - V and VI. As per Appendix IV the respective teachers shall undertake the revision of syllabus for the other semesters from II Semester to X Semesters.

Agenda 3: Any other matter with the permission of chair...

1. Introduction of Add on Course in English

The members of BOS unanimously felt the urgent need to sufficiently equip the Law students with language skills both spoken and written. As majority of students admitted in the Law School are from rural area and not adequately equipped with language skills, it is felt

necessary to introduce at least three Add-on Courses in English. First Add-on Course in English in I Semester with emphasis on Grammar. Second Add-on Course in English in II Semester with emphasis on enhancing Speaking Skills and Third Add-on Course in English in IV Semester with emphasis on Writing Skills and Translation Component.

This is further necessary in view of the fact that there is translation component in majority of the qualifying examinations to become a Judge, Prosecutor etc.

Resolution: It was resolved to introduce three Add on Courses in English

For I Semester Add on Course in English Grammar with syllabus as appended in Appendix - VII. It was further resolved that the course teacher shall undertake drafting of the syllabus for other two Add on Courses and submit to the Chairperson BOS.

2.Changes that are to be effected from the Academic year 2022-23.


Resolution: It was resolved to recommend to the University to adopt the below changes with effect from the Academic Year 2022-23 prospectively starting with the batches admitted to I Semester B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.).

1. Introduction of Major - Minor system for B.A., LL.B.(Hons.) as appended in Appendix -I
2. Reallocation of subjects as appended in Appendix - II for B.A., LL.B.(Hons.) and Appendix - III for B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)
3. Revised syllabus as appended for I Semester of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) in Appendix - V, and I Semester of B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) in Appendix - VI.
4. Introduction of Add-on course in English Grammar for I semester of B.A., LL.B.(Hons.) and B.B.A., LL.B.(Hons.)

Item No.1

Proposal from Dr. Rajani Kumari, Academic Council Member (Ref. Item No.5 of the Proceedings of the 85th Syndicate Meeting dated 9-1-2021)

- Either to exclude English subject for English medium students in 1st Semester, or
- To exclude Kannada subject for Kannada medium students in 2nd Semester

Resolution:

The Board discussed in detail the proposal (i) and (ii) from Dr. Rajani Kumari, Academic Council Member and it was unanimously resolved that proposal (i) cannot be considered in view of the fact that, under Bar Council of India, Rules of Legal Education 2008, Schedule V Section 1 it is provided that, in any University if the students are allowed to write in examinations in any regional language other than English, the students have to take English as compulsory paper.

Proposal (ii) cannot be considered in view of the Order of Higher Education Department, Govt of Karnataka on the basis of Dr. Borlingayya Committee Report that, in Professional Courses (Engineering, Medical, Law, etc.) Kannada has to be compulsorily taught.

Resolution:

The Board discussed in detail with regard to proposal (i). It was unanimously resolved that, in view of the fact that only during the pandemic situation the classes were conducted online hence the App may not be so useful for the students. And also the academic programs conducted for students at the University can be recorded and hosted on KSLU's website or on Youtube.

Item No.3:

In the syllabus of Law of Torts to include Consumer Protection Act 2019 instead of Consumer Protection Act 1986 as it has been repealed.

Resolution:

It was resolved to include Consumer Protection Act 2019 instead of Consumer Protection Act 1986 as it has been repealed. In the syllabus of Law of Torts under Unit – V, the following is inserted:

"Salient features of Consumer Protection Act 2019: Preliminary; Consumer Protection Councils; Central Consumer Protection Authority; Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission; Mediation; Product Liability; Offences and Penalties."

The following is deleted:

"Salient features of Consumer Protection Act, 1986: Who is consumer, Defects in goods, Deficiency in services, Medical services, Remedies to consumers, Consumer Disputes Redressal Agencies, Limitation for filing complaints, Penalties."

Further, the changed syllabus of Law of Torts will come into immediate effect i.e. from the Academic Year 2020-21 for the even semesters of 5 year LL.B Courses and 5 year LL.B. (Honor's) Courses.

And for the 3 year LL.B Course the changed syllabus of Law of Torts will come into effect from the Academic Year 2021-22.

It was resolved to issue Circular to all the Affiliated Colleges regarding the change in syllabus of Law of Torts.

Item No.4:

Proceedings of the Task Force Committee Meeting held on 9-3-2021 at KSLU, Hubballi.

Resolution:

It was resolved that for the 3 year and 5 year LL.B. Courses already the students are studying Kanoonu Kannada / Kannada Kali in One semester. Kanoonu Kannada is studied by Kannadiga students and Kannada Kali is being studied by non-Kannadiga students. In 3 year LL.B. Course, in each semester there are 5 subjects, but in 1 semester as per Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules 2008 as English Subject is compulsory there are 6 subjects and in II Semester, Kanoonu Kannada / Kannada Kali is being taught there are 6 subjects. As this being so, if Kannada subject has to be taught in one more semester, what should be the syllabus, and in which semester it has to be included needs a detailed consideration because as per Bar Council of India requirement for 3 year LL.B. Course the students are studying 31 subjects i.e. (20 Compulsory subjects, 4 Clinical subjects, 6 Optional subjects and 1 English subjects) and for 5 year LL.B. Course the students are studying 45 subjects, and Kanoonu Kannada / Kannada Kali as one more additional subject. As restructuring of subjects, revision and updating of syllabus is to be taken up by Board of Studies, there can be a detailed discussion regarding additional Kannada subject.

Item No.5:

Item No.1. Including of additional papers for the 3year LL.B. and 5 year B.A., LL.B., 5 year B.B.A., LL.B. and 5 year B.Com., LL.B., batches to admitted during the academic years 2016-17 and 2017-18, to bring the syllabus in conformity with the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education.

Resolution: As per the amended Rules of Legal Education of the Bar Council of India, there should be 20 compulsory law papers in the degree programme. Further, students who answer in the examination in any regional language other than English should take English as a compulsory paper. After elaborate discussions, it was resolved to include Constitutional Law-II, Labour Law-II and English Papers in appropriate semesters for different degree programmes as detailed below.

1. For 3 year LL.B. batch admitted during the academic year 2014-15 the Constitutional Law-II and Labour Law-II papers shall be added in 5th Semester and Labour Law-II paper shall be added in 6th Semester. The syllabus for these subjects shall be as appended in Appendix-4 Constitutional Law-II, Appendix-5: English and Appendix-10, Labour Law-II. The 3 year LL.B. batch admitted from the academic year 2015-16 onwards shall study English in 5th Semester.
2. For 2 year LL.B. batch admitted during the academic year 2012-13 the Labour Law-II paper shall be added to 4th Semester, Constitutional Law-II and English papers shall be added to 5th Semester. The syllabus for these subjects shall be as appended in Appendix-3, Constitutional Law-II, Appendix-4: English and Appendix-10: Labour Law-II.
3. For 2 year B.A., LL.B., 3 year B.B.A., LL.B. and 3 year B.Com., LL.B. batches admitted during the academic years 2014-15 and 2015-16 the Labour Law-II paper shall be added to 4th Semester, Constitutional Law-II and English papers shall be added to 5th Semester. The syllabus for these subjects shall be as appended in Appendix-3, Constitutional Law-II, Appendix-4: English and Appendix-10: Labour Law-II.

Item No.2. Adopting the Integrated Two Year Programme as enshrined in the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education.

Resolution: The members discussed the advantages and disadvantages of following the designed Two Year Law Degree programme model as enshrined in the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education. It was felt that there are distinct advantages of administering law courses right from the 1st semester of the 2 year law programme. It was resolved to discuss the subject for 3 year B.A., LL.B., 3 year B.B.A., LL.B. and 3 year B.Com., LL.B. programmes as shown in Appendix-IV, Appendix-V and Appendix-VI respectively.

Item No.3. Substitution of "Legal Methods" paper by the title of "Elements of Research" paper in Integrated Programme including Honours Programmes with effect from the academic year 2014-15.

Resolution: In order to multifacetedly widen the horizons of the integrated programme right from the initial stages and provide them an insight into the discipline of law, it was resolved that the "Legal Methods" paper be the place of "Elements of

Research paper. The syllabus for the Legal Methods paper shall be as appended in Appendix-VII.

Item No.4. Compulsory Kannada / Kannada Kafi papers of 3 year LL.B. and 5 year Integrated Programmes from 2018-19 onwards.

Resolution: Appreciating the need of Kannada language for the professional as well keeping in view the directions of *Kannada Akhara Akhara*, it was resolved that the students will study one Kannada paper compulsorily as appended in Appendix-VIII. The non-Kannada students shall study the paper on "Kannada Ka" and the syllabus shall be notified in due course. The students of Integrated Programme and the students of 3 year LL.B. shall study this course in their respective II Semesters.

Item No.5. Labour Law-I and Law of Taxation papers for Honours Programmes for batches admitted from 2019-20 onwards.

Resolution: In order to comply with the Bar Council of India rules, it was resolved to insert a paper on Labour Law-I in VIII Semester and Taxation paper in IX Semester. The syllabus for Labour Law-I shall be as appended in Appendix-XII.

Item No.6. Syllabi for Constitutional Law-I, Constitutional Law-II, Labour Law-I and Labour Law-II papers for 3 year LL.B. batches admitted from 2016-17 onwards and 3 year LL.B. batches admitted in the year 2018-19 onwards.

Resolution: It was felt that as far as possible to introduce Syllabi for Constitutional Law-I, Constitutional Law-II, Labour Law-I and Labour Law-II papers for 3 year LL.B. batches admitted from 2016-17 onwards and 3 year LL.B. batches admitted in the year 2018-19 onwards, it was resolved to prescribe the syllabus for Constitutional Law-I as in Appendix IX, Constitutional Law-II as in Appendix-X, Labour Law-I as in Appendix XI and Labour Law-II as in Appendix XII.

Item No.7. Introduction internal assessment for 20% of marks in each course.

Resolution: The members discussed in detail about professionalising law degree programmes by equipping the students with the oratory and writing skills. Further it was also made out that the UGC has directed the universities to allocate 20% of the marks to be awarded by way of internal assessment. In this regard, it was felt that now is the appropriate time for the University to introduce this component. Therefore,

It was resolved that unless otherwise provided for in each course carrying 100 marks, 20 marks shall be awarded by way of internal assessment. The end of the semester examination shall be conducted for 80 marks. It was further resolved that a student should secure a minimum of 40% of the marks in the end semester examination to be declared as pass in that paper provided, he has secured a minimum of 40 marks in that paper along with internal assessment marks. That is, a student has to secure a minimum of 32 marks in each paper in the end semester examination. These 20 marks shall be awarded as per the modalities appended in Appendix-XIII.

For remaining 80 marks, there shall be end semester examination conducted by the University. The question paper pattern shall be as below:

1. There shall be questions from each unit.
2. For each unit there shall be 16 marks that shall be apportioned as under:
 - a. 10 marks for essay answer part (a) of the question.
 - b. 6 marks for short answer or problem question- Part (b)
3. Each Unit shall have two essay questions and two short answer / problem questions of which the student shall answer one each.

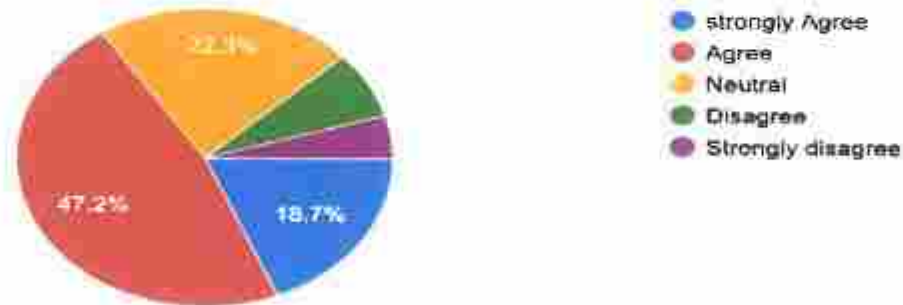
