Karnataka State Law University, Hubli invites application from the eligible applicants for admission to following courses in Law, for the academic year 2013-14 in the Constituent college at Hubli and its affiliated Law Colleges across Karnataka -

- 1) 3 years LL.B., degree course
- 2) 5 years B .A. LL.B. / B .B .A,LL.B.,Integrated degree course
- 3) 5 years B.A,LLB [Hons] , B.B.A,LLB [Hons]., Integrated degree course
- 4) 2 years LL.M.

The admissions should be as per the Admission Rules of K.S.L.U as given below.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:

- The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognised University/Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in a Foreign country shall **compulsorily obtain** the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE before taking the admission in the affiliated law college, by applying
- ✓ either through Principal of the affiliated law college as per the procedure.

:ACADEMIC SECTION:

- ✓ or directly in person, to the office of K.S.L.U., Hubli along with all original marks cards of 10th, 12th Std & U.G. Degree's.
- Fees for Eligibility certificate for both LL.B and LL.M is Rs.1600/- for Indian students and Rs.7000/-for Foreign students. DD should be drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, K.S.L.U., Hubli payable at Hubli.
- The DD should be drawn separately and submitted along with Eligibility application. The amount for obtaining eligibility should not be clubbed with the DD submitted for admission purpose.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES:

1. Instructions to the affiliated Colleges regarding the admissions to various classes of 3 year LL.B., 5 year LL.B. and LL.M., Courses for the academic year 2013-14.

The applications for admission and the admission statement should be as per format prescribed by KSLU, Hubli. The admission statements in Proforma~1 and 2, shall be forwarded to the KSLU official email ID: caseworker.acad.kslu@gmail.com(SZ) & kaksluacademic9@gmail.com(NZ) on the dates specified in Academic Calendar~2013-14.

The eligibility for admission is as given below:

A) 3 year LL.B. course -

(a) An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for three year degree course in law leading to the conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted under the KSLU Regulations.

(b) Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants and 40% of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

(c) Maximum age for seeking admission is limited to 30 yrs (thirty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 35 yrs (thirty five years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and other OBC as on 1st August 2013.

*** There is a Writ Petition pending at the Supreme Court of India regarding the maximum age limit prescribed for admission and the same will be subject to the status/condition/the final judgment by the court, on the date of admission.**

Explanation:-(i) An applicant who has passed the 3 years U.G. degree & 2/3 years P.G. degree from Open or Deemed University recognized by & established under the UGC Act, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of 10+2 at Secondary/Higher Secondary Schooling is eligible for admission

(ii) An applicant will be held eligible, if doesn't have prescribed minimum percentage of marks in U.G. Degree examination either in aggregate or at final year, but has passed the P.G. degree examination with prescribed minimum percentage of marks, provided he/she have prosecuted the study pattern in 10+2+3+2/3 format.

:ACADEMIC SECTION:

The applicant who has passed the qualifying examination (U.G. or P.G. degree) in a single sitting examination without having any of the basic qualifications of (10+2+3) is not eligible for admission to 3 yr LL.B Law Course of KSLU, Hubli.

B) 5 yr Integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A. LL.B./ B.A.LL.B. [Hons]/ B.B.A.LL.B. [Hons] Courses:

(a) An applicant who has successfully completed Pre-University course or Senior Secondary School course (+2) or equivalent such as (11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by the State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the course.

Provided those applicants who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission to the course.

(b) Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants and 40% (39.5% and above shall be treated as 40%) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

(c) Maximum age for seeking admission is limited to 20 yrs (twenty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 22 yrs (twenty two years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and OBC as on 1st August, 2013.

*** There is a Writ Petition pending at the Supreme Court of India regarding the maximum age limit prescribed for admission and the same will be subject to the status/condition/the final judgment by the court, on the date of admission.**

Explanation:

i) An applicant who has passed the 11th/12th/Pre Degree Course examination from State/Central Boards of Schooling or from Open Schooling System recognized & established under the Government of the State/India or International Board of School education, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of 1 to 10 standards, at Secondary Schooling.

ii) The applicant who has passed the prescribed minimum qualification in a single sitting examination without having basic qualification (1 to 9th std. of schooling) is not eligible for admission to 5 yr LL.B Law Courses of KSLU, Hubli.

iii) Provided further that the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation or post graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission to the course.

C) LL.M Courses:

a) Minimum Qualification: An applicant who has graduated in Law discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent National Institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for Two year P.G. degree course in law leading to the conferment of LL.M. degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted under the KSLU, Regulations.

:ACADEMIC SECTION:

- b) Minimum percentage of marks: In all the years/semesters of qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants and 40% of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

2) All Subsequent years (classes) of all law courses:

- a) The Principal shall verify the promotional eligibility of the students for admission to next class/year of the course.
- b) The admissions for subsequent years shall be made as per Admission Time Table 2013-14 and duly filled in Admission application and the previous semester marks cards shall be verified & submitted to K.S.L.U, Hubli at the time of admission approval.
- c) The Statement of admission in proforma-1 & 2 shall be submitted to the K.S.L.U. on the dates mentioned in Academic Calendar ~2013-14 under s.no.06.
- d) The Proforma no: 03-09, of admission statements shall be binded into a single booklet of A4 size along with the covering letter (with fee paid DD details) addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubli, and be submitted in duplicate at the time of original document verification.
- e) Incomplete application are liable to be rejected.

3) ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- a) Admission to the course are made strictly on the basis of the merit as prescribed by the admission rules of Karnataka State Government.
- b) A 5% of total sanctioned seats (i.e. intake) shall be kept reserved for the Kashmiri Migrants until the last date of admission as per the orders of Govt. of India, Dept. of HRD, New-Delhi. If left unfilled after the last date of admission, may be allotted to the candidates of open merit awaiting for admission in the waitlist.
- c) Provided that while making admission to the course reservation Rules of the Government of Karnataka governing admissions to higher educational institutions issued from time to time shall be observed.

4) FEES

All college principals are strictly instructed to collect the fees as prescribed by the University's fees structure for the year 2013-14.

5) INTAKE

- a) No College or Department of Studies in Law shall admit the students in excess of the sanctioned intake.
- b) The University shall reserve the right to prescribe/review the intake & number of divisions in each Law Course/College or the Department of Studies in Law, as per need, adhering to the orders & guidelines issued by the B.C.I. & Government authorities.

6) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITY SHOULD VERIFY -

- ☞ The eligibility of the students as per KSLU admission regulations, before admitting the students to the Law Courses.

:ACADEMIC SECTION:

- ☞ The students shall be asked to produce the Migration and Transfer Certificates within one month from date of admission.
- ☞ Incase of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant should have obtained the valid passport/visa and “Students Study Permission” from Foreign Embassies of both the nations.
- ☞ The students shall submit the pending documents for admission approval within one month from the date of provisional admission approval by the University.
- ☞ At the time of documents verification by University for admission approval, the college should submit the originals above said documents & ‘Eligibility Certificate’ (wherever necessary).
- ☞ The Principal of the college shall verify the original documents and attest the copies thereof.
- ☞ The Principal of colleges should certify that the admissions (for all classes) of Law Course/s are made as per the admission rules of Karnataka State Law University, Hubli and Government of Karnataka.

7) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITIES SHALL ENSURE SUBMISSION OF THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS BY THE APPLICANT TO THE COLLEGE, AS BELOW.

- ☞ 10th Std. marks card &/certificate for age/Birth date proof, P.U.C./12th Std/H.S.C. or any equivalent examination marks cards in case of 5 years LL.B. admission, at the time of admission
- ☞ 10, +2 and U.G. Degree Marks cards of all years/Semesters & Passing certificate incase of 3 year LL.B. admission, at the time of admission.
- ☞ The Eligibility Certificate issued by the University, incase of Non-Karnataka and Foreign students (for both 3 year & 5 year LL.B. courses), at the time of admission.
- ☞ The Transfer & Migration Certificates shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission or within one month from the date of admission to the college.
- ☞ Incase of SC/ST/Cat-1 student, Caste & Income certificate shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission.
