## Eligibility Criteria:

## 3 year LL.B. course

(a) An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for three year degree course in law leading to the conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted under the KSLU Regulations.
(b) Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below $45 \%$ ( $44.5 \%$ and above shall be treated as $45 \%$ ) of total marks in case of general category applicants and $40 \%$ of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
(c) Maximum age for seeking admission is limited to thirty years in case of general category of applicants and to thirty five years in the case of applicants from SC, ST and other backward communities as on $1^{\text {st }}$ June.
Explanation :-(i) An applicant who has passed the 3 years U.G. degree $\& 2 / 3$ years P.G. degree from Open or Deemed University recognized by $\&$ established under the UGC Act, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of $10+2$ at Secondary/Higher Secondary Schooling is eligible for admission.
(ii) An applicant will be held eligible, if doesn't have prescribed minimum percentage of marks in U.G. Degree examination, but has passed the P.G. degree examination with prescribed minimum percentage of marks, provided he/she have prosecuted the study pattern in $10+2+3+2 / 3$ format.
The applicant who has passed the qualifying examination (U.G. or P.G. degree) in a single sitting examination without having basic qualifications of $(10+2+3)$ is not eligible for admission to 3 yr LL.B. Law Course of KSLU, Hubli. 5yr B.A./B.B.A. Courses:
a. An applicant who has successfully completed Pre-University course or Senior Secondary School course (' +2 ') or equivalent such as ( $11+1$, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by the State Government or from any equivalent institution form a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the course.
b. Provided those applicants who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission to the course.
c. Provided further that the applicants who have obtained $10+2$ or graduation or post graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission to the course.

## :ACADEMIC SECTION:

(b) Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below $45 \% ~(44.5 \%$ and above shall be treated as $45 \%$ ) of total marks in case of general category applicants and $40 \%$ ( $39.5 \%$ and above shall be treated as $40 \%$ ) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
(c) Maximum age for seeking admission is limited to twenty years in case of general category of applicants and to twenty two years in the case of applicants from SC, ST and other backward communities as on $1^{\text {st }}$ June, 2011.

Explanation: i) An applicant who has passed the $11^{\text {th }} / 12^{\text {th }} /$ Pre Degree Course examination from State/Central Boards of Schooling or from Open Schooling System recognized \& established under the Government of the state/India or International Board of School education, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of 1 to 10 standards, at Secondary Schooling is eligible for admission to 5 year LL.B Courses.

The applicant who has passed the prescribed minimum qualification in a single sitting examination without having basic qualification ( 1 to $9^{\text {th }}$ std. of schooling) is not eligible for admission to 5 yr LL.B Law Courses of KSLU, Hubli.
