Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi invites application from the eligible applicants for admission to following courses in Law, for the academic year 2017-18 in its Law School and affiliated Law Colleges.

- 1) 3 years LL.B.,degree course
- 5 years B.A. LL.B. / B.B.A,LL.B. and B.Com.,LL.B. Integrated degree course. 2) 3)
- 5 years B.A,LLB (Hons), B.B.A,LLB (Hons)., Integrated degree course

The admissions should be as per the Calendar of Admission and Admission Rules of K.S.L.U as given below.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

- The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognized University/Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in a Foreign country shall compulsorily obtain the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE before taking the admission.
 - Such candidates may apply for the Eligibility Certificates to the KSLU in the prescribed form by post or in person by paying necessary fees, to the office of K.S.L.U., Hubballi along with attested documents of 10th, 12th Std & U.G/P.G. Degree's, as applicable along with transcripts issued by the concerned University or Board or Department.

- ✓ The Eligibility Certificate will be issued by the KSLU Academic Section at Hubballi for those candidates who have obtained their qualifying degree/certificate outside the Karnataka state and all the foreign candidates/applicants.
- ✓ The qualifying degree/certificates should be in Kannada or English only.
- ✓ All those candidates who have obtained qualifying degree/certificate from outside the Karnataka state should produce the countersigned original certificates from the issuing authorities/universities, otherwise eligibility will not be considered.
- ✓ The students who have studied qualifying examination +2 under C.B.S.E, Board, New Delhi are exempted from eligibility certificate for admission to 5yr Law course.
- > Fees for Eligibility certificate for LL.B Rs.2200/-(Two thousand two hundred) for Indian students and Rs.11,000/-(Eleven thousand) for Foreign students.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Instructions to the affiliated Colleges regarding the admissions to various classes of 3 year LL.B., 5 year BA/BBA/B.Com.,LL.B. and 5 year BA/BBA.,LL.B.(Hons) Courses for the academic year 2017-18.

The applications for admission and the admission statement should be as per proforma prescribed by KSLU, Hubballi. The admission statements in Proforma-1 and 2, shall be forwarded to the KSLU official email ID: caseworker.acad.kslu@gmail.com (South Zone) & kaksluacademic9@gmail.com (North Zone) on the dates specified in Academic Calendar 2017-18.

The eligibility for admission is as given below:

A) 3 year LL.B. course:

- (a) An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for **Three year degree** course in law leading to the conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted under the KSLU Regulations.
- **(b) Minimum percentage of marks** in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants and 40% (39.5% and above shall be treated as 40%) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
- **(c)** <u>Maximum age</u> * for seeking admission is limited to 30 yrs (thirty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 35 yrs (thirty five years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and Other Backward Communities as on 15th May 2017.

Explanation:-

- (i) An applicant who has passed the 3 years U.G. degree & 2/3 years P.G. degree from Open or Deemed University recognized by & established under the UGC Act, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of 10+2 at Secondary/Higher Secondary Schooling is eligible for admission.
- (ii) An applicant will be eligible, if he/she obtains 45% of marks in P.G.Degree, provided that he/she has prosecuted the study pattern in 10+2+3 format.
- (iii) The applicant who has passed the qualifying examination (U.G. or P.G. degree) in a <u>single</u> <u>sitting</u> examination is not eligible for admission to 3 yr LL.B Law Course of KSLU, Hubballi.

B) <u>5 yr Integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B./B.COM.LL.B./B.A.LL.B.(Hons)/B.B.A.LL.B.</u> (Hons) Courses:

(a) An applicant who has successfully completed Pre-University course or Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent such as (11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by the State

Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the course.

- **(b) Minimum percentage of marks** in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants and 40% (39.5% and above shall be treated as 40%) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
- (c) <u>Maximum age *</u> for seeking admission is limited to 20 yrs (twenty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 22 yrs (twenty two years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and Other Backward Communities as on 15^{th} May 2017.
- * A Writ Petition (civil) No. 1023/2016 pending before the Supreme Court of India regarding the maximum age limit prescribed for admission. The admission of the students who have crossed the age limit is subject to the outcome of the said writ petition. In this regard, college has to obtain an undertaking from the students who have crossed the age limit in the proforma enclosed.

Explanation:

Provided that the applicants who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission to 5 year & 3 year LL.B., course.

Provided further that the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation or post-graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission to the Law course.

2) All Subsequent years (classes) of all law courses:

- a) The Principal shall verify the promotional eligibility of the students for admission to next class/year of the course. In this regard, principal has to enclose the certificate stating that, the student has fulfilled the promotional eligibility criteria for the course.
- b) The admissions for subsequent years shall be made as per Admission Time Table 2017-18 enclosing all previous semester marks cards.
- c) The Statement of admission in proforma-1 & 2 shall be submitted to the K.S.L.U. on the dates mentioned in Academic Calendar 2017-18 under sl.no.05.
- d) The Proforma no: 03 to 09, of consolidated admission statements in A4 size papers shall be bound into a single booklet along with the covering letter (with details of fee paid) & shall be addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi, and be submitted at the time of original document verification.
- e) Incomplete applications shall be liable to be rejected.

3) ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- a) Admission to the course shall be made strictly on the basis of merit. While making admission to the course reservation policy of the Government of Karnataka governing admissions to higher educational institutions issued from time to time shall be observed.
- b) 2 seats under supernumerary quota shall be reserved for the Jammu and Kashmir students within the sanctioned intake until the last date of admission as per the orders of Govt. of India.
- C) 5% of seats shall be reserved for the Kashmiri Migrants until the last date of admission as per the orders of Govt. of India, Dept. of HRD, New-Delhi. The persons claiming the status of Kashmiri Migrants should produce the identity card issued by the Jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner and District Magistrate of the Government of Karnataka to this effect.
- d) Reservation for Hyderabad Karnataka students under Art 371(J) as per rules shall be adhered to 8% of the seats shall be reserved for them.

e) 3% of seats shall be reserved for physically challenged students as per rules applicable.

4) FEES

- a) All Principals are strictly instructed to collect the fees as prescribed by the University and Government of Karnataka.
- b) The college shall apply to concerned District Social Welfare Dept for the reimbursement of SC/ST students fees & should remit to the University.

5) INTAKE

No College shall admit the students in excess of the sanctioned intake.

6) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITY SHOULD VERIFY -

- a) The eligibility of the students as per BCI rules & KSLU admission regulations before admitting the students to the courses.
- b) The students shall be asked to produce the Migration and Transfer Certificates within one month from date of admission.
- c) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant should have obtained the valid passport, visa, Residential permit, and "Students Study Permission/NOC" from Foreign Embassies of both the nations. They should also obtain a certificate that the degree is obtained from a recognized Board/University from the concerned embassy in India.
- d) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant shall be asked to produce the "Equivalence Certificate" issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi if necessary.
- e) At the time of documents verification by University for admission approval, the college should submit the originals of above documents & 'Eligibility Certificate' (wherever applicable).
- f) The Principal of the college shall verify the original documents and attest the copies thereof.
- g) The Principal of colleges should certify that the admissions (for all classes) of course/s are made as per the admission rules of Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi and Government of Karnataka.
- h) In case a student is an employee either in State/Central/Private organization, he shall submit a study permission letter from concerned employer stating that the working hours do not conflict with college timings and the Principal should certify that the candidate is capable of attending 70% of classes.

7) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITIES SHALL ENSURE SUBMISSION OF THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS BY THE APPLICANT TO THE COLLEGE, AS BELOW.

- a) The Eligibility Certificate issued by the University, in case of Non-Karnataka and Foreign students (for both 3 year & 5 year LL.B. courses), at the time of admission.
- b) 10th Std. marks card & P.U.C./12th Std/H.S.C. or any equivalent examination marks cards in case of **5 years LL.B.** admission, at the time of admission
- c) 10, +2 and U.G/P.G. Degree Marks cards of all years/Semesters & Passing certificate in case of **3 year LL.B.** admission at the time of admission.
- d) The Transfer & Migration Certificates shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission or within one month from the date of admission to the college.
- e) In case of SC/ST/Cat-1/OBC student, Caste & Income certificate shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission.
- Soft copy Proforma No: 03 shall be submitted through email on very next date after closing the admission dates as mentioned in the academic calendar 2017-18 (caseworker.acad.kslu@gmail.com and kaksluacademic9@gmail.com)
- Consolidated admission statement in Proforma No: 03 along with admission applications with necessary attested documents to be submitted at the time of original documents verification.

- The Proforma No: 04 to 10, of admission statements along with the covering letter (with details of fee paid) addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi, and be submitted at the time of original document verification.
- Incomplete information in the Proforma will be rejected and admissions of the college will not be approved or may be withheld for want of information.
- The serial numbers of candidates in subsequent admission statements viz, Proforma III, shall be in continuation with the 1st list of admission statement.
- Admission statement in proforma III should be prepared as per the date of admission serially and not in alphabetical order.
- Fees collected shall be remitted through a single D.D. drawn in favour of Finance officer, KSLU, Hubballi. The admission statements and the D.D. shall be submitted to the Registrar, KSLU along with the **Proforma No: 01** containing details of fees.

Note:

- 1) In complicated/doubtful cases, the principal of the college may seek clarification from the Academic Section.
- 2) The college/s shall admit the student/s only after verification of the necessary documents & eligibility certificate for fulfillment of eligibility criteria, as detailed in the K.S.L.U. Admission rules. In case any college admits in-eligible candidate/s to any course, the Principal will be responsible for further consequences in the matter of non-approval of such admission/s and the Principal is liable for a fine of Rs.10,000/- for each of such admission.
