THE KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY'S REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE FIVE YEAR B.A., LL.B. INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE IN LAW (AMENDMENT), 2011

The Academic Council of the Karnataka State Law University makes the following Regulations under Section 34(2)(iii) read with Section 49 of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.

Whereas the Karnataka State Law University's Regulations governing the five year B.A., LL.B. integrated degree course in Law have come in to force from the date of assent of Chancellor, i.e., 15th June 2009, and whereas it is considered necessary to amend the said regulations for the reasons hereinafter appearing, namely:

- 1. Title and commencement- (1) These regulations may be called as "the Karnataka State Law University's Regulations Governing the five year B.A., LL.B. integrated degree course in Law (Amendment), 2011."
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their approval by the Chancellor.
- 2. Amendment of regulation 15- In the Karnataka State Law University's Regulations governing the Five year B.A., LL.B. Integrated Degree Course in Law, in Regulation 15, for clause (a), the following shall be substituted, namely:

"(a) No student shall be promoted to the next year of the course unless he/she has passed in a minimum of two subjects in either semester or one subject in each semester."
