THE KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITIES REGULATIONS GOVERNING FIVE YEAR B.A.,LL.B., B.B.A., LL.B. & B.A.,LL.B.(HON'S), B.B.A., LL.B.(HON'S) INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE IN LAW (SECOND AMENDMENT), 2011

The Academic Council of the Karnataka State Law University makes the following regulations under section 34(2) (iii) read with section 49 of the State Law University Act, 2009.

Whereas the Karnataka State Law Universities Regulations Governing five year B.A., LL.B., B.B.A., LL.B. & B.A., LL.B.(Hon's), B.B.A., LL.B.(Hon's) integrated degree courses in Law have been issued on 18-06-2009 and 23-07-2011 respectively and whereas it is considered necessary to amend the said regulations for the reasons hereinafter appearing, namely:-

- 1. Title and commencement.-(1) These regulations may be called Karnataka State Law Universities Regulations Governing five year B.A., LL.B., B.B.A., LL.B. & B.A., LL.B.(Hon's), B.B.A., LL.B.(Hon's) integrated degree course in Law (Second Amendment), 2011.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their approval by the Chancellor.
- 2. Amendment of Regulation 13.- In regulation 13 of the Karnataka State Law Universities Regulations Governing five year B.A., LL.B., B.B.A., LL.B. & B.A., LL.B.(Hon's), B.B.A., LL.B.(Hon's) integrated degree course in Law, after the first proviso, the following second proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided further that the shortage of attendance of a student due to his/her representing the institution/university in extra curricular activities such as NSS, NCC, Moot Court, Sports and other similar activities recognized by the institution or the University to the extent of number of days of his/her participation inclusive of period spent for journey shall be condoned on production of attendance certificate issued by the competent authority."
