

Amendments to Regulations Governing The 5 Year B.A., LL.B. Integrated Degree Course In Law (Fifth Amendment), 2020

<p>Rule 15. (a) No students shall be promoted to the next year of the course unless he/she has passed in a minimum of two subjects in either semester or one subject in each semester</p> <p>(b) Students are required to successfully complete the entire course within ten years from admission to the course.</p>	<p>Rule 15. (c)</p> <p>The candidates who have taken admission to 5year B.A.,LL.B Course and have not succufully completed their degree within 10 years from the date of their admission shall be given an extension of one year comprising of two consecutive attempts to complete their degree from the date of Notification.</p>	<p>The candidates who took admission for the academic years 2009-2010 and have not been able to successfully complete their degrees even after the end of ten years. Students have submitted their representations to the office of Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka, the Chief Minister of Karnataka, the Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs, Syndicate members and various authorities. All their representations are forwarded to the University for needful action, Given the fact that, in spite of investing ten years of the precious time many of the students have failed in one or two subjects, and hence have not completed their degrees.</p>
