STATUTE RELATING TO POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF PURCHASE COMMITTEE

[Under Section 43 of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009]

1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT


- a) This Statute may be called as the “Statute Relating to Powers and Functions of Purchase Committee”.
- b) They shall come in to force from the date of assent of the Chancellor.


2. DEFINITION:


In this Statute unless the context otherwise requires the words and definitions used but not defined shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the respective law for the time being in force.

3. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF PURCHASE COMMITTEE :

- a) Every proposal to purchase made in University, excluding library books shall be referred for approval of the purchase committee.
- b) Every Department and Sections of the University shall refer the proposal to the Purchase Committee along with Tenders, Quotations, Comparative Statements and other documents for scrutiny and approval by the committee.
- c) The Purchase Committee shall have powers to demand for the production of any documents in connection with proposal of purchase of items by the department or sections as the case may be and such departments or sections shall supply with such information as early as possible. The proposal referred by the departments or sections shall follow procedures contemplated in the Karnataka Transparency and Public Procurement Act, before sending the proposal to the purchase committee.
- d) While scrutinizing the proposal received from every department or sections, purchase committee shall also ensure the compliance with the provision of Karnataka Transparency and Public Procurement Act before according its approval and making recommendations to the Syndicate.
