Certificate course on Para-Legal Services

Syllabus for Certificate Course on Paralegal Services

Objectives:

This course intends to develop a functional understanding of the Indian legal system and laws that affect individuals in day-to-day life. It aims to impart elementary skills of accessing grievance redressal institutions and their processes. The aim is to create a cadre of paralegal volunteers who would strengthen the legal aid delivery system by bridging the gap between people, especially the most vulnerable, and the legal system by embarking upon legal literacy programmes and facilitating access to justice. This course introduces the students to constitutional and statutory framework relating to legal system, legal aid, role and responsibilities of paralegal volunteers; also equip them with necessary drafting and other skills to be effective exponents of cause of justice and fill the role of paralegal volunteer effectively.

Course Content:

Unit-I

Law as an instrument of social change, law & social justice, legal interventions in poverty alleviation and gender equity. Constitution of India and its framework – Preamble, fundamental rights, directive principles of state policy, state's obligation to provide free legal aid, fundamental duties, Public Interest Litigation (PIL), Introduction to Indian legal and Court system– Civil Courts, Criminal Courts, Higher Judiciary, Tribunals, Human Rights Commissions and Human Rights Courts.
